Public Health

Agency	Naloxone Access
Sterling Pharmacy	Free emergency naloxone kits and training, as well as prescription fulfilment. Fentanyl test strips available.
Walgreens	Naloxone is available over the counter without a prescription at all Walgreens
Cash Wise Pharmacy	Participating pharmacy with Naloxone protocol (Pharmacists can prescribe Naloxone and it will be run through insurance when applicable to determine cost)
CVS Pharmacy (Owatonna Target)	Prescription fulfilment and consultation.
Walmart Pharmacy	Participating pharmacy with Naloxone protocol.
Allina Health Owatonna Hospital Retail Pharmacy	Opioid overdose kits, Take it to the Box Disposal program. A prescription is needed for a Naloxone kit.
HyVee Pharmacy	Participating pharmacy with Naloxone protocol
South Country Health Alliance (Genoa Pharmacy)	Covers Naloxone with a prescription for members.
Law enforcement	All county law enforcement and EMTs carry Naloxone.
Schools	In the process of implementing Naloxone policies
Steve Rummler HOPE Network	Free online training; following training Naloxone kits can be picked up for free at all Naloxone access point (NAP) sites; see below
