# **Ackie Monitor Care Guide**

#### **Basic Info**

Species: Varanus acanthurus (Ackie Monitor, also called Spiny-Tailed Monitor)

Lifespan: 12-20+ years in captivity

Adult Size: 20-28 inches (including tail)

Temperament: Active, intelligent, and typically very handleable with regular interaction

Best for: Intermediate reptile keepers or advanced beginners with proper setup knowledge

### **Enclosure Setup**

Tank Size:

- Babies: 40-75 gallon minimum

- Adults: 4x2x2 ft (minimum) - larger is better for enrichment

- Provide horizontal floor space and deep substrate

### Temperature & Heating:

- Basking spot: 120-140°F

- Ambient daytime temp: 80-90°F

- Cool side: 75-80°F

- Night: 70-75°F

- Use halogen bulbs, ceramic heat emitters, or radiant panels

#### Humidity:

- Ambient humidity: 30-50%

- Provide humid burrows (60-70%) using layered substrate

- Monitor with digital hygrometer

#### Lighting:

- High-output UVB required (T5 HO 10.0 or Arcadia 12%)
- 12-hour light/dark cycle
- Basking platform should be within UVB range

#### Substrate:

- 8-12 inches of a diggable mix: organic topsoil, play sand, and clay
- Must retain burrow shape and allow natural behaviors

#### Décor & Enrichment:

- Logs, rocks, branches, basking ledges, and secure hides
- Offer tunnels, tubes, and digging opportunities

## **Diet & Feeding**

#### Feeding Frequency:

- Babies: Feed daily

- Adults: Feed 3-5x/week

#### Diet:

- Staple: roaches, crickets, BSFL, hornworms, superworms
- Occasional: boiled egg, cooked chicken, pinky mice (adults only)
- Avoid: fatty meats, cat/dog food, or feeder insects not gut-loaded

#### Supplementation:

- Calcium without D3: 3-4x/week
- Multivitamin: 1x/week
- Gut-load insects before feeding

#### Water & Hydration:

- Shallow water dish available for drinking
- Mist occasionally to maintain burrow humidity

## **Handling & Behavior**

#### Handling:

- Start slow and build trust
- Support full body and allow to climb on hand/arms
- Very curious and interactive with consistent care

#### Behavior to Expect:

- Diurnal and extremely active
- Will bask, dig, climb, and chase insects
- Curious and intelligent can recognize feeding tools and caretakers

## **Supplies Checklist**

- 4x2x2 ft enclosure (minimum for adults)
- High-output UVB and intense basking bulb
- Digital thermometer, thermostat, and hygrometer
- 8-12 inches of diggable substrate mix
- Strong basking décor and hides
- Gut-loaded insect feeders and supplements
- Shallow water dish and enrichment items
