Haliburton

This drive will take you approx 45 minutes depending on where you are in the park.

How to get there from Wilberforce

Turn right at the fire hall in Wilberforce and take the Essonville Rd to Hwy 118 (formerly 121). Turn right on Hwy 118 and continue into Haliburton.

There is a route along the Kennaway Rd.(which is unpaved) that leads off the Burleigh Rd. a few kms outside the west entrance to the park. Take this at your own risk as the surface can be variable depending on weather conditions. This route passes through the Haliburton Scourt Reserve land. It can cut 10 minutes or so off the journey if conditions are good. This road is not ploughed in the winter.

Bancroft

This drive will take you approx 45 minutes depending on where you are in the park.

How to get there

From the ends of either the Burleigh Rd or Elephant Lake Road turn left on to Hwy 648. Proceed until you reach Highland Grove. Turn left on to Diamond Lake Road and proceed until you reach Hwy 62. Turn right on to Hwy 62 and continue approx 1 KM in to Bancroft.
