
Highlights

Roots Rock and Roll and R&B



Based out of Greensboro, NC, the band features upbeat songs that get your feet moving. Their music pulls styles from the roots of Rock & Roll and R&B, including West Coast Swing, Chicago Blues, Memphis Rockabilly, Elvis and a dose of Chuck Berry. This is the music the Stones, Beatles and Allman Brothers were listening to and playing at the start of their careers.

The JumpStarters take songs from 1945-1965 and give them a new twist. The common thread is it makes you move. It could be shuffling your feet or full on dancing; this music makes you move.

The Band started in 2015 and features Bryan Smith on Vocals and Guitar, Steve Blake on Saxophone, Doug Dennis on Bass and Roy Brown on Drums. The JumpStarters have played swing dances, clubs and festivals across the Carolinas, including performances at MerleFest in 2018 and 2021. These music veterans are ready to introduce this style to a whole new generation.

In April of 2024, Smitty and the JumpStarters released their third recording as a digital only release. The first single "Let's Walk" hit the ground not walking but running. It was instantly embraced by the Beach Music community and many of the DJ's. By the Summer of 2024 it hit #1 on the Beach Music Top 40 chart.

"Let's Get Jumpstarted" is the 2nd CD from Smitty and the JumpStarters, released April, 2020. It came out at the beginning of the pandemic shut down which meant no live gigs to promote the new CD. Internet radio became the outlet for many bands including the JumpStarters during that period. The CD hit the Cashbox charts and the songs were heard on radio all over the world.

"ROCK WITH ME"

John Hook's Roadhouse Blues and Boogie Chart.

"Rock With Me" #1 for 5 weeks and 52 weeks on the chart

"Rock With Me" also crossed over to Fessa Hook's Beach Top 40 Chart. It made it to #3 on that chart and spent 28 weeks on the chart.

"Rock With Me" came in as the #23 overall song on Hook's Beach Top 40 chart for the year 2020.

"LET'S GO JUMPIN"

John Hook's Roadhouse Blues and Boogie Chart:

"Let's Go Jumpin" #1 for 4 weeks and 47 weeks on the chart.

"Let's Go Jumpin" reached #6 on The Wave (99.1) Countdown with Eric Bowman and spent 20 weeks on the chart.

"HEY! BA BA RE BOP"

"Hey! Ba Ba Re Bop" charted as high as #18 and spent 19 weeks on Fessa Hook's Beach Top 40 Chart.
