Entering its' 4th year, the Sheldon's Daylight Camp is a coed youth football camp designed to utilize football as a tool to engage and educate 4th-6th graders in Indianapolis, Indiana on the importance of education, healthy lifestyles, hope and perseverance through sports.

## **CAMP SCHEDULE**

**Day 1** - Participants will pick up their registration packets which includes a swag bag with sponsor product, PPE kit, two t-shirts (1 for all day STEM and financial literacy camp and 1 for football activities) and camp lanyard.

Parents will have an opportunity to hear an inspiring message from Darrin Gray of All Pro Dad's. Students will engage in physical and education activities to kick off the camp.





## **CAMP SCHEDULE**

**Day 2** - Participants will rotate through 6 stations similar to a school day gaining exposure to 4 STEM related activities and 2 Financial Literacy activities.

STEM activities will be provided by STEMNASIUM and will include:

"S" SCIENCE: FIZZ WIZARD

"T" TECHNOLOGY: Come Fly with Me

"E" ENGINEERING: Engineers Boulevard

"M" MATH: Come Slime with Me

Financial Literacy activities material will be provided by Junior Achievement of Central Indiana.

Supplies and meals (breakfast and lunch) will be provided by Sheldon's Daylight Camp.







## **CAMP SCHEDULE**

**Day 3** - With a team of high school football coaches, current NFL players and volunteers, participants will be divided into groups to go over various football skill drills. Friendly speed competitions between teams will determine the fastest camper and awards will be given at the end. Team pictures will be taken for each group. Student groups will also present their projects as part of the STEM/Financial Literacy Competition.
