To: Parents of Students Participating in PVIS Athletics -

Welcome to the PVIS Booster Club Athletic Program. Congratulations to your student for making a team and representing PVIS in the South Bay League.

In order to participate in the school's athletic program, your child is required to maintain a 2.0 or higher GPA and a citizenship mark of "S" or above. In addition, there are two forms listed below that **MUST** be received before the first game or meet, or your child will not be eligible to participate. You may turn in the completed and signed forms, along with your uniform deposit (see details on the Player/Parent Code of Conduct form), to the coach or to the PVIS front office. The two required forms are:

- (2) Emergency Card**

PVIS Booster Club Player/Parent Code of Conduct

Player

- A 2.0 or higher GPA and a citizenship mark of "S" of higher must be maintained to participate on a PVIS Booster Club athletic team.
- All school and District rules and regulations that apply to student behavior during the regular school day also apply during Booster Club sponsored athletic events.
- Refrain from unsportsmanlike gestures, language, profanity and taunting. Exhibit fair play and sportsmanship.
- The Athletic Director or coach reserves the right to release any player from the team/sport for, but not limited to, poor sportsmanship, lack of cooperation, poor attitude, lack of commitment, effort or attendance.
- Cooperate and show respect for your coach, teammates and opponents.
- All players will show respect towards the game officials and their decisions. All decisions made by the officials are to be accepted as final. No player should argue a call or judgment.
- Accept the coach's decisions regarding playing positions and amount of playing time. There are no guarantees for equal playing time or position – all are subject to the coach's discretion.
- Win with character, lose with dignity.

Parent

- Accept the coach's decisions regarding playing positions and amount of playing time. There are no guarantees for equal playing time or position – all are subject to the coach's discretion.
- Always respect the game officials' decisions.
- Remember – your child should be participating in sports for his or her enjoyment, not yours; help us to promote a positive attitude and not focus on winning or losing.
- **Please attach to this form a \$40 uniform deposit check made out to: PVIS Booster Club.** Once you have turned in this form (with a check attached) and the Emergency Card, your child will receive his/her uniform and be eligible to participate in games. At the end of the season, your child must turn in his/her uniform at the designated time (most likely a team party), and then they will receive the deposit check back. Checks will be cashed only if a player does not turn in his/her uniform at the designated time.
