7/7/2022

The Board of Supervisors Exeter Twp. Wyoming County, held their meeting for the month of June on 7/7/2022. The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call: David Thorpe-present, Richard Fitzsimmons-present, Timothy Pierce-present. All others signed in via attendance sheet.

A motion was made by Richard and seconded by David to approve previous minutes.

Roll call: David-yes Richard-yes Timothy-Yes. Motion carried.

Treasurer report: General fund checking \$76,740.25, cap improv. fund \$118,712.91, park checking \$10,622.72, cc account \$499.93, impact \$47,189.13, sr water \$1273.09, recovery account \$33,266.01, total general accounts \$288,304.04. State fund checking \$165,808.48 Total all account \$454,112.52.

Motion made by David and seconded by Tim to approve Treasurers report. Roll call: David-yes, Richard-yes, Tim-yes. Motion carried.

Bills for the month have been reviewed and signed - motion was made by Richard and seconded by David. Roll call: David-yes, Richard-yes, Tim-yes. Motion carried.

Road report: Tim spoke on the potholes near playground. Rachael spoke regarding phone call from Andrew. Falls Twp will come with grader and dump to do the ditch from parking lot down to bridge. Will be filled in with stone. No charge from Falls Twp. Tim spoke on the stop sign needed to be replaced at Olsen Road he will install. David mentioned the pothole on Hickory and Bash Road. Andrew will fill with cold patch. Motion made by Richard and seconded by David to improve River Road by bridge to pavilion. Roll call: David yes, Richard yes, Tim yes. Motion carried. Tim spoke to resident on Coolbaugh Mountain Road about replacing a pipe. He will let him know its ok to proceed on replacement.

Building and zoning report: Ron Jackson gave his report. David Thorpe requested a permit for a new garage on Hickory Lane. He received a call from a resident about the proposed skate park and advised resident to attend the meeting. Received call from resident about a property on Susquehanna Beach Rd. Ron went to location, property owner was in touch with SEO. David spoke about the previous building plans he had located. He has given two contractors the plans to give a rough order estimate.

SEO: no report

Park report: Tim advised the zipline is down he received a quote to replace it \$3704.00. Richard made motion and seconded by Richard to allow Tim to spend up to \$1500 on park zipline. Roll call: David yes, Richard yes, Tim yes. Motion carried.

Senior Center report: David spoke on deficit we have for senior center. We will address deficit with total cost of senior center and how to make that up. I.e., Keep deficit or ask for rental increase. We want to have those number to review in September. Much discussion regarding senior center and use of the building if we lose tenant. David recapped the water system project. He advised we are waiting for the grant to get approved from the County for the water system and also the roof. Spoke on the fines we are dodging and that we are waiting to hear from the County on when we will receive the funds to avoid the fines.

Old business: Coolbaugh Mountain Bridge – David spoke on the project that Tim is going to oversee this project and keep in contact with the project manager Jason Snyder. Nancie spoke on Northmorland Township waiting that we have dust control in the garage. Rachael will reach out to see if truck is working. Clean-up date is scheduled for 7/30 no Tv's. There was much discussion regarding the skate park. Hiring police was mentioned. Tim spoke on Creek Rd, The homeowner is working on getting their

property fixed we are also looking to get a estimate from his contractor to replace the pipes we need replaced. Lockville Rd tree down. The tree has been cleaned up and paid for. Signs at the kayak launch Tim will install. Wood carpet has been purchased and put down. Request for winter work is on hold till next month.

New Business: Motion made by David and seconded by Tim to open an equipment account with all 3 Supervisors and Secretary/Treasurer as signers with 2 signatures required for each transaction. David spoke on tree on Susquehanna Beach Dr the tree is not Township property. State auditor was at building for audit will get report in two to three months. Richard spoke on the trash at PFBC and not a Township issue to clean up. We need to contact fish commission to clean it up. Resident spoke on people BBQing and camping on township property. Also discussed contacting the fish commission on where the property lines are. Richard spoke on kayak launch and riverbank excavating that was done. Richard would like the township to put back the soil that was removed and reconstruct the riverbank to where it was previously. David spoke to wait a month for more discussion.

Motion made by David and seconded by Tim to amend and renew DGK insurance policy with monthly billing. Roll call: David yes, Richard yes, Tim yes. Motion carried.
