Festival of Trees


Once again our lodge is participating in the beloved Rochester

O, Lutefisk!

The October 9 program featured Chris Dorff, manager of Olsen Fish Company in Minneapolis. Chris reviewed the history of the company (no longer owned by the Olsen family) and the present-day operations. He described how lutefisk is made and admitted that the factory is as odiferous as one would expect! Chris was accompanied by his daughter Hannah and her fiancé, who helped serve a delicious variety of herring in traditional flavors, as well as the new Cajun spice flavor. Olsen Fish herring is available in all the HyVees as well as most other grocery stores and may be labeled differently.

From our Financial Benefits Counselor

In my last article I talked about a Christmas gift of a life insurance policy for your grand— and great-grandkids and the reasons why it's a good idea to do so. I referred to a Viking Voyager and a Single Premium Whole Life policy. Here is a sample of what the cost is.

Viking Voyager, issues age 0 to 17:

Age Face Amt. Premium			A	ge Face Amt.	Premium
0	\$10,000	\$362	0	\$25,000	\$504
5	\$10,000	\$341	5	\$25,000	\$477
10	\$10,000	\$326	10	\$25,000	\$475

These are one-time premiums, and coverage goes until age 26, at which time they can convert to a Whole Life policy.

For the Single Premium policy, the minimum premium is \$2,000, payable one time. Here are two examples:

Age	Face Amt. Premium (male)		Age Face Amt. Prem. (female)			
0	\$12,022	\$2,000	0	\$13,096	\$2,000	
5	\$10,840	\$2,000	5	\$11,692	\$2,000	

This policy accumulates cash values, and the face amount increases.
