Sons of Norway is a fraternal benefit and cultural organization whose purpose is to preserve the Norwegian heritage in North America and to strengthen the ties between North America and modern Norway.

Sons of Norway was founded in 1895 in Minneapolis, Minnesota, by 18 young Norwegian immigrants to provide mutual help in sickness, distress, and fellowship in their new land.

For over 100 years Sons of Norway has offered its members both protection and opportunities for cultural expression as the world's largest ethnic fraternal benefit society of its kind.

Sons of Norway has over 55,000 members in 380 lodges in Canada, the United States, and Norway.

The Kristiania lodge is located in District 1 of the Sons of Norway organization. Kristiania #1-47 celebrated its centennial on May 20, 2005.

Article VI

These By-laws may be repealed or amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the membership present and voting, provided that such By-law changes were presented in writing and read at the prior meeting of the lodge.

The By-laws, and any changes thereto, shall become effective upon approval by the International Headquarters. The By-laws of this lodge are subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Charter and Constitution of the International Lodge of Sons of Norway.

Article VII

- 1. Kristiania Lodge #47 Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice President, Past President (Counselor), Treasurer, Secretary, Financial Secretary, and three Trustees,
- 2. They shall act, on behalf of the Lodge in all matters involving investments.
- 4. They shall make recommendations to the Board on other matters of importance to the Lodge.
- 5. Decisions shall be made by a majority vote of those present and voting with each person having one vote.
- 6. A quorum shall be necessary for any decisions by the Executive Committee. A quorum shall consist of five members.
- 7. They shall hold quarterly meetings and may hold other meetings at the discretion of the President or by a majority vote of the Executive Committee.
- 8. The Secretary shall keep minutes of each meeting. In the absence of the Secretary, a recorder shall be appointed.
- 9. Quarterly reports shall be made to the board.
- 10. The President shall preside at each meeting. In the absence of the President, the Vice President shall preside.

Article III

Fees and Dues

All fees and dues are set by the international organization. A portion of the dues are returned to the local chapter.

Article IV

Good Standing

- 1. A member who is in arrears 120 days in the payment of dues shall not be eligible for any benefits of the lodge, and shall be subject to suspension in accordance with procedures set forth in the Constitution.
- 2. A member who pays all back dues and assessments shall be reinstated effective with their original date of membership

Article V

Lodge Funds

- 1. Appropriations to defray the running expenses of the Lodge shall require only a simple majority vote for adoption. Other appropriations from the Lodge funds shall require a two-thirds majority of votes cast for adoption.
- 2. The lodge shall maintain one or more funds. The General fund shall be used to defray the running expenses of the lodge.
- 3. The financial officers of the Lodge are covered by a blanket position bond, as provided in the Constitution, with a deductible for each claim, which surety bond is maintained by the Home Office.
- 4. The Lodge shall participate in the mandatory liability insurance for District and Local Lodges as secured by the International Headquarters. This insurance does not cover lodge-owned real estate or buildings, or liquor liability claims.

Constitution and By-laws Sons of Norway Kristiania Lodge #47

Article I

Lodge Name and Meetings

- 1. The Name of this Lodge shall be **Kristiania**, No 47, Sons of Norway, Rochester, Minnesota, District 1
- 2. Regular meetings shall be held at such time and place as the Lodge itself shall determine. Special meetings may be called in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws of Sons of Norway.
- 3. Business meetings will be the 2nd Thursday of each month, unless the Executive Board elects otherwise Article II

Membership Qualifications and privileges

- 1. To become a member of Sons of Norway, the applicant will be accepted, at the time the dues have been paid
- 2. The membership shall consist of insurance and non-insurance members either of whom may be Life, Golden, Honorary members in accordance with the Constitution.
- 3. Life membership shall be extended to all members who were 65 years of age or older and who had been members in good standing in the Sons of Norway for 30 years or more by January 1, 1999.
- 4. Golden membership shall be extended after January 1, 1999 to all members who are 65 years of age or older and who have been members in good standing in the Sons of Norway for 30 years or more.
- 5. All members shall enjoy equal privileges, except that only those with insurance shall have the right to vote on matters concerning insurance.
- 6. Affiliate membership. Members possessing a current membership card of a different lodge may petition for affiliate membership.
