Welcome to the Sons of Norway, Kristiania Lodge 1-047, **Post High School Scholarship Program for 2019**. Our Lodge will be granting up to six, \$500 scholarships to students enrolling in a college, university, junior college, or technical school for the fall term beginning in September. To be eligible, you must be a graduating high school senior from a public high school in Olmsted County or a son/daughter, grandchild or great grandchild of a current Kristiania Lodge

member—regardless of the school you attend or the county/state where you live.

For those attending a public high school in Olmsted County, information about the program is available through your high school guidance counselor. For those living elsewhere, or attending a non-public high school, the information may be downloaded from our web site: www.kristiania1-47.org.

The application process includes **six parts**. Each part must be completed and mailed to: **Kristiania Lodge, Scholarship Committee, 2124 Viola Road, NE, Rochester, MN 55906—by March 31, 2019**.

Part 2 of 6 Submit an official high school transcript. **Request your transcript from your guidance counselor the (10) school days prior to the postmark due date, March 31, 2019.**

Part 3 of 6 Provide a statement of registration or letter of acceptance from the college, university, junior college, or technical school you will be attending on a full time basis in the fall of 2019.

Part 4 of 6 Include a resume citing **community service, work experience, and high school activities** you participated in during your high school career.

Part 5 of 6 Write an essay of between 250 and 300 words describing your post high school goals and your educational goals. Explain how you would benefit from a Kristiania Lodge Scholarship.

Part 6 of 6 Include a minimum of one personal reference with an attached letter of recommendation. Your personal reference must be someone other than a relative.

REMINDER: Identify any relative who is a current member of S/N Kristiania Lodge 1-047. **NOTE:** Affiliation with a current Kristiania Lodge member **is not a requirement** to be selected for a scholarship.

Selection and Notification Process

- Early in April, after all applications have been received, the Executive Committee will meet and review them. Attention will be given to each part before making a final decision. The Lodge may grant up to six scholarships.
- All applicants will be notified by mail of their status, including those not selected.
- Scholarship recipients, and their parents or guardians, will be invited to attend our Lodge meeting on Thursday, May 9, at 7:00 p.m. At that time, scholarship certificates will be awarded and students will be introduced to our membership.
