



A Norwegian to watch in the Olympics—

Two-time world champion Karsten Warholm broke a 29-year-old world record in the 400 meter hurdles July 1 in the Diamond League meet in Oslo. The 25-year-old Norwegian finished in a 46.70 seconds to break the mark of 46.78 set by American Kevin Young in the 1992 Barcelona Olympics. Warholm's previous best was 46.87 in Stockholm last August. —AP News

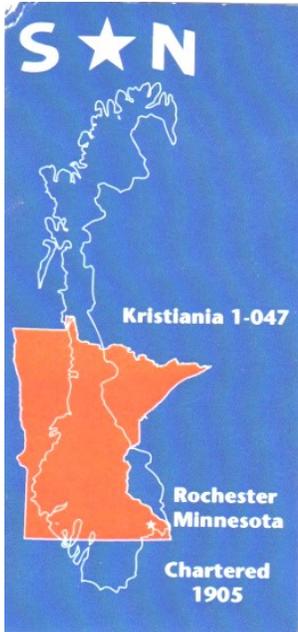
