



Skit (at 2:15): Early ministers at the St. Olaf parish preached often against fraternal societies, such as the Masonic Lodge or Odd Fellows, which they called unchristian. Life insurance offered by the lodges also was frowned upon. These issues are explored in the skit through life choices confronting a young farm boy at the time of the outbreak of World War I.
