
New in the Kristiania Library—



A Book Review

(submitted to fulfill an elective requirement for Sons of Norway Cultural Skills, Literature: Part 2)

The Water's Edge by Karin Fossum is a Nordic crime novel which takes place near a small town in Norway. The central characters are Konrad Sejer and Jakob Skarre, two policemen attempting to solve the murder of a young boy and to locate a second boy. Other characters are a couple whose marriage is on the rocks, as well as the mothers of the two boys. The action moves at a fairly rapid pace, the characters are believable, the plot's twists and turns fascinating, and the conclusion is satisfying but surprising. I recommend the book to crime fiction fans. It is available for check-out in the Kristiania library.


