His talent for art became clear while studying at Luther College in Decorah, IA, and local benefactors helped make it possible for him to study in Oslo and Munich. Back in the United States, Gausta became a successful artist, completing more than 400 altar paintings during his lifetime.

Kristiania will participate in the Festival of Trees again




Our theme is "Nordic Sweet
