| Professor Kristin Anderson Presents Program on | Norwegian-American Artist September 8



Kristin Anderson is a distinguished Professor of Art at Augsburg University in Minneapolis. She will speak to us on Herbjørn Gausta, a lead-

ing light among Norwegian-American immigrant artists.

Emigrating as a child, Gausta returned to Europe to study art before establishing his studio in Minneapolis. He remained tied to his fellow immigrants, especially with the 400 or so altar paintings he made for Norwegian-American congregations. In this presentation, we will learn about Gausta's fascinating life and look at his beautiful altar paintings.

I Kristin's current writing and research is focused on sports I architecture, and she is co-authoring a book on the histo-I ry of sports facilities in the Twin Cities.




