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Roosevelt Neighborhood

- Walk score: 71; bike score: 76
- Walk to Barkley Village (.5 miles) to catch a movie, eat out or pick up your groceries.
- Walk to Trader Joes (< 1 mile) to stock up on snacks for a garden gathering, or walk to nearby breweries
- Hop on the <u>Railroad Trail</u> (<.5 miles) for a leisurely walk or bike ride through the neighborhood and city, with forested areas and views of Bellingham Bay from the Alabama bridge, or to picnic and swim at Bloedel Donovan Park
- Or hop on a bus (<.5 mile), if you need to go further, but don't want to drive



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
