



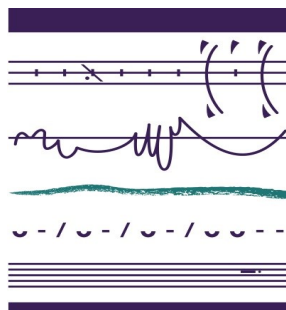
NORTHERN STARZ'S PENGUIN PROJECT WILL BE OPEN FOR REGISTRATION FEB. 1ST!!!
