Two invoices were added to the list of bills to be paid at this meeting: Soliterio & Tierney, CPA's (\$9,000.00) for the annual financial audit, chargeable to the 2017 Professional Services appropriation and Amwell Autobody (\$10,923.47) for repairs to Car 45, chargeable to the 2017 General Operating appropriation. Insurance has reimbursed this expense.

<u>Activities</u> – Robert Wood Johnson has proposed stationing a paramedic unit office at the firehouse in its efforts to improve services and response to the area – discussion between the parties is upcoming.

The AED's have been added to Car 45-1 and Tanker 45. Members attended Kingston FD's wetdown recently.

REVIEW OF 2016 FIRE DISTRICT AUDIT REPORT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-15 requires the governing body of every local authority to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year ended December 31, 2016, has been filed by a Certified Public Accountant with the State of New Jersey, Division of Local Government Services pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:5A-15, with the Treasurer of the Board of Fire Commissioners of Montgomery Township Fire District No. 1, with the Municipal Clerk of the Township of Montgomery, and a copy has been received by each member of the Board of Fire Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-17 requires the governing body of each authority to, within 45 days of receipt of the annual audit report, certify by Resolution to the Local Finance Board that each member thereof has personally reviewed the annual audit report, and specifically the sections of the audit report entitled "General Comments" and "Recommendations", and to evidence same by group affidavit in the form prescribed by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed the Annual Report of Audit, and have specifically reviewed the sections of the audit report entitled "General Comments" and "Recommendations" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-17; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the regulation of the local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, and in addition shall forfeit his office.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the governing body of Montgomery Township Fire District No. 1 certifies to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that each governing body member has personally reviewed the Annual Audit Report for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2016, and specifically has reviewed the sections of the audit report entitled "General Comments" and "Recommendations", and has evidenced same by group affidavit in the form prescribed by the Local Finance Board; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Board of Fire Commissioners of Montgomery Township Fire District No. 1 is hereby directed to promptly submit to the Local Finance Board the aforesaid group affidavit, accompanied by a certified true copy of this Resolution.
