<u>**Call To Order</u>** -- The regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Spohn, following proof of publication in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act. The Annual Meeting Notice was published in the official newspaper of the district and provided to the Montgomery News and Packet Publications, filed with the municipal clerk, posted at the Montgomery Township municipal building, the board's office and on the fire district website, and provided to any person requesting same prior to the meeting.</u>

<u>Roll Call</u> -- Upon Roll Call the following Commissioners were present: W. Spohn, T. Karsay, W. Hyncik, J. Kessler, M. Parise. Absent: None. Also present: Engineer Lemon and Attorney Griswold.

Approval of Minutes– The Board reviewed the minutes of the January 8, 2019 regular meeting.Motion to approve the minutes of the January 8, 2019 board meeting as presented.
Motion made by Hyncik.2nd by Karsay.Motion passed without objection.

TREASURER'S REPORT

<u>Monthly Bills/Financial Statement Review</u> -- A copy of the Treasurer's report was made available to each Commissioner with a list and description of the bills to be paid. Additions to the list of bills: Arthur Crawford (\$300.00) and AnnaMarie Crawford (\$300.00) both chargeable to the 2019 Election appropriation. Amendment: increase amount encumbered for the purchase of the tool sets approved last month and to be paid at this meeting to \$251.84 (General Operating).

<u>2019 Fire District Election</u> – Two petitions were submitted for the two 3-year seats on the board. Commissioners Parise and Hyncik will open and close the polls. Due to new rules costs associated with this year's election will include the cost of a poll book, printing and scanning mail-in ballots, and expenses charged by the county for services rendered.

Motion to pay expenses associated with the upcoming election and budget referendum. Motion by Kessler. 2nd by Spohn. Passed without objection.

RESOLUTION 2019-16 – Authorizing Payments for Election.

The Chief Financial Officer having certified there are sufficient unencumbered funds in the 2019 temporarybudget, authorization to pay up to \$1,200.00 for miscellaneous election costs to be billed by Somerset Countyand/or its vendors, all chargeable to the 2019 Election appropriation.Resolution Ayes: Spohn, Karsay, Hyncik, Kessler, Parise.Nays: None.Absent: None.

LOSAP –Commissioner Karsay presented the certified list of active volunteers who qualified for LOSAP awards in 2018. 30 volunteers qualified for an award.

Loose Equipment Storage - Some fire district equipment and supplies crowding the firehouse are being allowed storage in the garage on the property next door. A question arose for future discussion as to whether paying the utilities in the garage (roughly \$1,400.00 per year) would be appropriate compensation for its use.

Deputy Chief Vehicle (Car 2) – While having the box tie emblem fixed it was apparent that the vehicle also needed new tires and brakes. Between meetings Commissioner Spohn was contacted and gave approval for the work.

Motion to ratify approval of the purchase and installation of four new tires and brakes for Car-2.Motion by Hyncik. 2^{nd} by Karsay.Motion passed without objection.

RESOLUTION 2019-18 - Approving Purchase and Repairs for Car 2.

The Chief Financial Officer having previously certified there were sufficient unencumbered funds in the 2019 temporary budget, ratification of authorization to have the brakes repaired and new tires purchased and installed on Car 2 by Harlingen Garage at a cost of \$1,503.73, chargeable to the 2019 General Operating appropriation.
