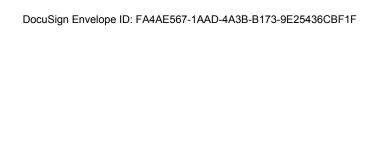

The entire increase is for the purchase of a new tanker/pumper and will be funded by drawing from the restricted capital fund. The budget does not require any borrowing or tax increase.

Election expenses are reduced by \$1,000 from \$9,000 to \$8,000 reflecting actual costs from the prior year. General Operating expenses are increase by \$10,000 reflecting price increases experienced in the current year. Interest revenue is increased from \$5,000 to \$40,000 reflecting increased revenue earned on BOFC bank deposits. Personnel expenses decreased because no one was hired.

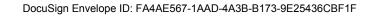
