# **AREAS OF COMPETITION**



## **COMMUNITY SERVICE 15%**



Community Service is a new and exciting area of competition that encourages contestants to actively engage in community outreach and service. This segment focuses on how well contestants participate in various community events within Brampton, showcasing their commitment to making a positive impact and giving back to the community.

Contestants are expected to attend and participate in any community event, supporting causes, and contributing to initiatives that help improve the local community. This may include volunteering at charity events, helping organize community gatherings, or participating in local fundraising activities.

Judging will be based on the number of events attended, the level of engagement in each event, and how well contestants represent the pageant during their service. Contestants will be required to submit a portfolio containing photos or any proof of participation at each event. This portfolio must be handed in on the day of the interview to verify their involvement.

The Community Service segment not only highlights the contestant's dedication to community but also emphasizes the pageant's values of giving back, leadership, and creating a lasting positive influence.

#### **FORMAL WEAR 25%**

Contestants are encouraged to display elegance and confidence as they grace the stage. For this segment, a long formal dress or gown in any colour that reflects your personality is a perfect choice. You may pair your look with heels or flats, but running shoes are not permitted, as we aim to maintain the sophistication of this special occasion.

During the Formal Wear segment, judges will evaluate your overall grace, poise, and confidence as you showcase your unique style. This is your moment to shine —radiate charm and sophistication as you take the stage with pride and elegance, leaving a lasting impression.





#### **COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD**

#### **PUBLIC SPEAKING AWARD**

Two winners will be chosen: the Mini Public Speaking Awardee and the Grand Public Speaking Awardee. These winners inspire others with their words and leave a lasting impression. The Public Speaking Award honors their talent for connecting with people and sharing their thoughts in a powerful way.



#### **FRIENDSHIP AWARD**



The Friendship Award is a special recognition chosen by the contestants themselves. Throughout the pageant journey, participants form meaningful bonds, supporting and encouraging each other. This award reflects the spirit of unity and the true essence of being part of our pageant family.
