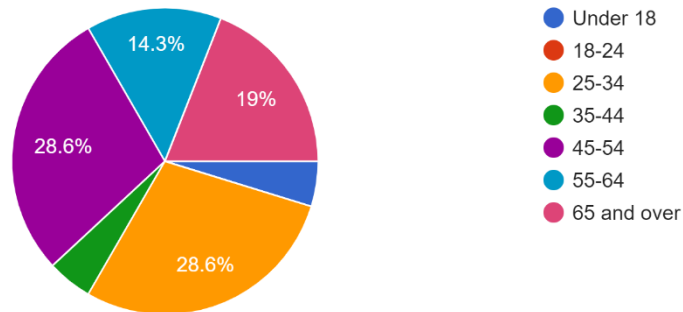


## 2024 Cordesville Community Center Survey Results

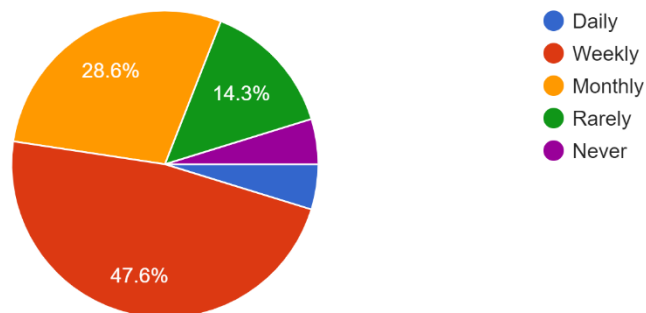
### What is your age group?

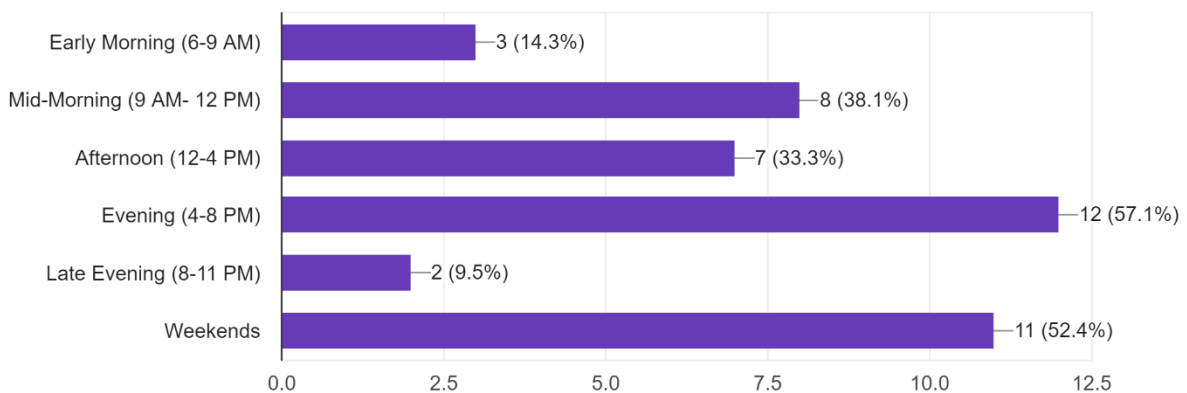
### How often do you think you would use the community facilities?

### What hours of operation would be most convenient for you? (Select all that apply)

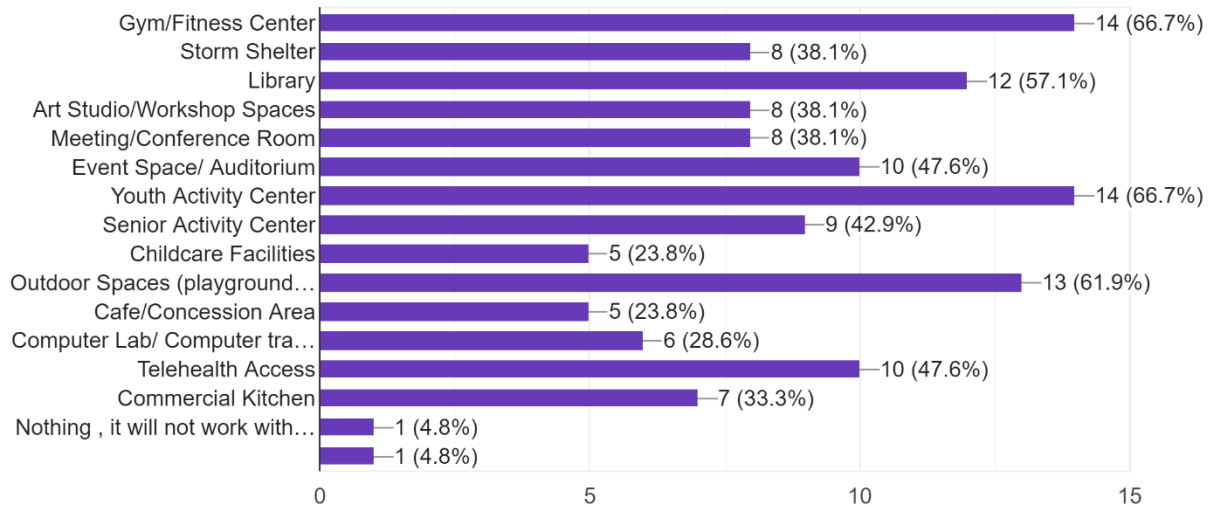

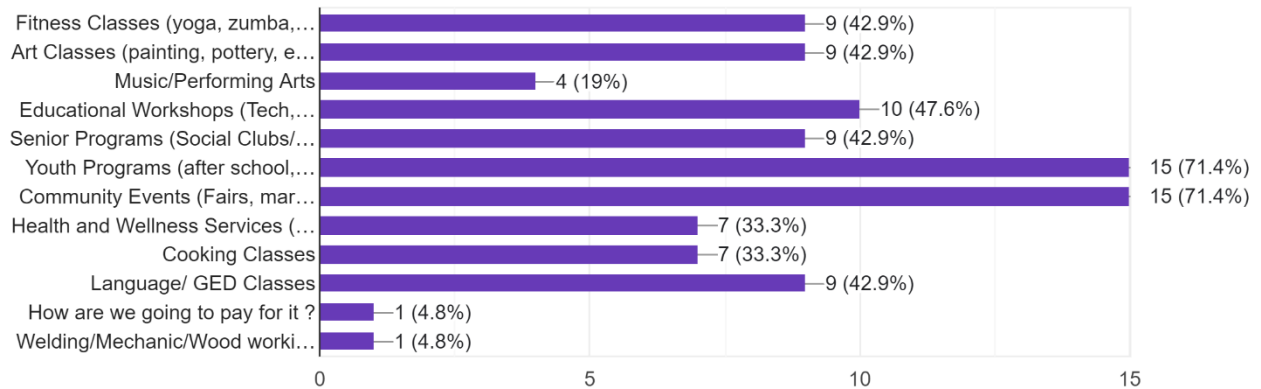
Which facilities would you like to have in the community center? (Select all that apply)

What types of programs or classes are you most interested in? (Select all that apply)

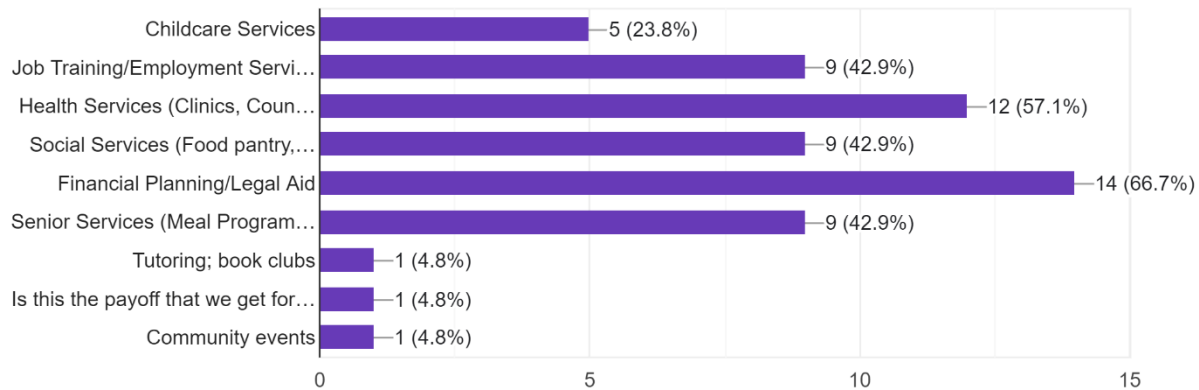

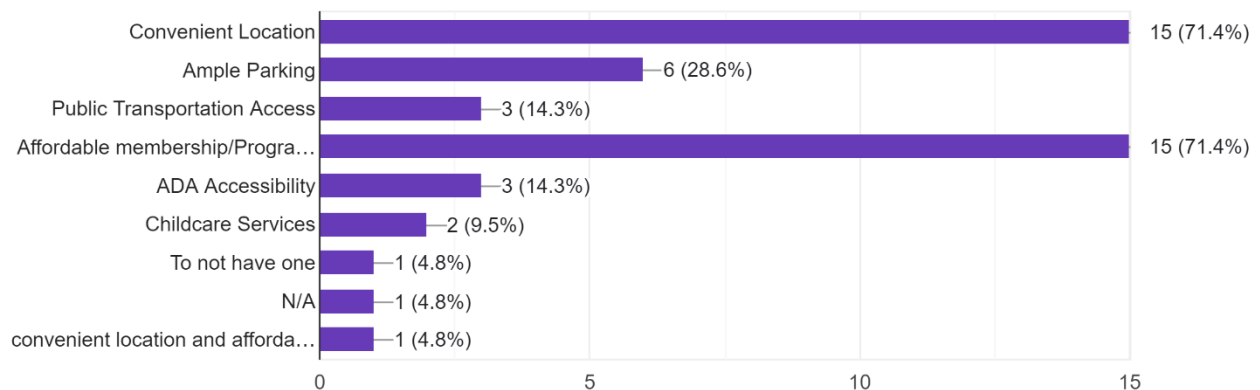
### What services would you find most beneficial? (Select all that apply)
