Old business

New business

- Community Action Team update was presented by Cpl. Joshua Phillips. He stated that there had only been one call this past month for a problem. Traffic enforcement had been busy in the area, particularly at night on 402. They were putting in the moveable signs that blink "your speed is". He also reminded that with school getting out, need to take safety precautions regarding property and driving.
- 2. Big news is the obtaining of the food truck. We didn't qualify for funds as there has been no response from Steve Davis. Another council member is willing to help fund the trailer if Davis leads the way.
 - a. The food truck payments are \$300/mo. We have insurance quotes for the trailer of \$600/year, but a tow-vehicle is \$4000/year—still looking at alternatives.
 - b. Food service certification is required for the manager.
 - c. Mr. Quigley has offered to help us get stuff at cost through Watermark.
 - d. We will nee food volunteer help.
 - e. We will put our logo/decal on it. A decal is \$500—we are going to look for sponsors aiming for 3 at \$5000/each with all funds for sponsorship going to the trailer loan
 - f. The food trailer is NOT for personal use but will be beneficial for...
 - i. Community fundraiser
 - ii. Educational opportunities (customer service, work skills, etc.)
 - iii. Disaster relief—provide food
- 3. We have a gentleman offering karate classes once we have our building. We'd like to be able to provide scholarship/fee assistance to community members as needed.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:25 p.m. with prayer led by Melanie.
