Answer: Yes

How many children are you licensed for?

Answer: 12

Are you and your assistant CPR/1st Aid trained?

Answer: We both received our training together.

Do you have an assistant?

Answer: Yes.

How many assistants do you have?

When are you and your staff closed for holidays and vacations?

Are payments still required when parents go on vacations?

Answer: Yes.

When are payments due?

Answer: Monday's mornings before dropping off your child.

If children are sick, are parents required to pick them up? (Ex. Pink eye or fever)

Answer: Yes. No longer than an hour after being informed via call or text.

Do you participate in USDA Food Program?

Answer: Yes.

Are you and your assistant required to pass background checks?

Answer: Yes.

Are the toys cleaned on a daily basis?

Answer: Yes.

Do you hold spaces?

Answer: No. It's first come first serve.

Do you do drop offs and pick-ups from school?

Answer: Not at this time.

When did you start your home daycare?

Answer: 2005

What do the children do during the day?

Answer: We read to the children, go over the days of the week, they color, go over flash cards; with the ABC's and letter sounds, numbers, shapes, colors, beginning words, singing, dancing, and puzzles.

What are the parents required to bring for their children?

Answer: Diapers, wipes, and change of clothing

What time is best to setup interviews for daycare?

Answer: The best hours are from 9 am-11am and then after 6pm.

Do the providers take classes throughout the year?

Answer: Yes, all providers are required to take classes. We get a **catalog** for Early Children.
