With a continuing focus on fine arts and fine crafts, this unique, successful event blends entertainment, food and an inspirational setting. With the century-old mill and river in the background, this park makes a perfect spot for the area's largest art event of the year.

ELIGIBILITY – Only original work handmade by the artist is eligible for the show and sale, including authors. No molds, kits, ceramics from molds, food items, etc. No items contracted out and/or made by someone else and/or resale items. Limited editions must be signed, numbered and many not constitute more than 20% of display. Failure to return on Sunday will result in ineligibility for future Festivals. Only the media represented in your application photos and approved may be sold. Failure to comply may result in removal of items, or in some instances, to leave with no refund. **Food artisans will now be accepted, must be home-processed, home-canned or home-baked foods and must follow the same eligibility requirements as listed above. Food artisans must be licensed as needed for the type of product they produce.**

MEDIA CATEGORIES – Media categories are listed on the application.

BOOTH AND ENTRY FEES - Space fees – 10 x 10 is \$200; 10 x 15 is \$300; 10 x 20 is \$400 and 10 x 30 is \$600. Limit of 3 spaces and spaces are not transferable. Entry fee will be cashed when accepted and nonrefundable. If an applicant is not accepted, registration fees will be returned. No refund given once notified of acceptance, but written notice of cancellation is still required to keep in good standing for future Festivals.

REGISTRATION, SET-UP, UNLOADING AND PARKING – Registration on Friday will be from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. with set-up continuing until 9:00 p.m. OR registration on will be on Saturday from 6:00 to 8:00 a.m. with set-up continuing until 9:00 a.m. **YOU MUST BE REGISTERED BY 8:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY.** Exhibitors shall provide their own display, including tables and chairs. Exhibitor parking is by permit in the designated area. Security is provided for Friday and Saturday night. Items left in your booth will be at your discretion. Phelps Mill Country does not assume responsibility for losses. Details and additional information will be sent in the confirmation letter.

ARTIST IMAGES – All applicants must submit 4-6 digital images loaded on a USB flash drive. New applicants must submit an image of their booth. Images must be in JPEG format. SLIDES, PHOTOS AND CDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. **Please do not email your images. Mail your application and images in an envelope with sufficient postage. You must include a Self-Addressed/Stamped Envelope with your application.** If you would like your flash drive returned, please be sure your return envelope will accommodate the size of your media and with appropriate postage Your name must be on your flash drive.

DEADLINE – Applications must be postmarked by **APRIL 1st** in order to be considered. Notice of acceptance or rejection will be mailed out in May, **DEPENDENT ON WHEN YOUR APPLICATION WAS RECEIVED.**

REVIEW COMMITTEE – Selections will be made on the basis of artistic merit, originality, creativity and craftsmanship. The entry should show the best of your work. Decisions made by the review committee will be considered final.



Reminders and News for 2026:

1. In order to draw a larger crowd for Saturday afternoon, the Phelps Mill Festival Board is continuing the **Craft Beer and Wine Tasting.** This will run from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and will take place at the north end of the Festival grounds. We are locating it on the north end so set up of these booths will not interfere with the other activities happening at that time.
2. Please send the self-addressed-stamped envelope with your application. **This is needed whether you want your flash drive back or not.**
3. **For all artists that recommend our show to a new artist, and if they are accepted in 2026, we will provide you with \$100 off your registration for 2027.**
4. **We want to thank you for your interest in the Festival, whether you are new or a past artist. We appreciate all of you and this Festival would not happen without you!**
