1. States with statutes that specifically refer to the state Medicaid program are checked. Other states may cover services for the diagnosis and treatment of PANS and PANDAS via regulatory measures such as Oregon or the definition of health insurance plans utilized in the statute may encompass the Medicaid program.

2. States with statutes establishing an annual awareness days are checked. Other states have passed measures to declare awareness days in a particular year that are not part of the state statutes.

3. The Arkansas legislature currently funds a clinic annually in its appropriations bills. See [2025 SB 128](#) for FY 2026 funding of \$175,000. In 2025 the Arkansas House recommended a measure, HB 1573, for further study in the Interim, which would modify the statute section concerning the development of the protocol.

4. State employee health benefit coverage may have been extended for additional plans years.
