

CLOCKWORK POOLS: The Routine Care Timeline

- How to care for your pool with minimum effort

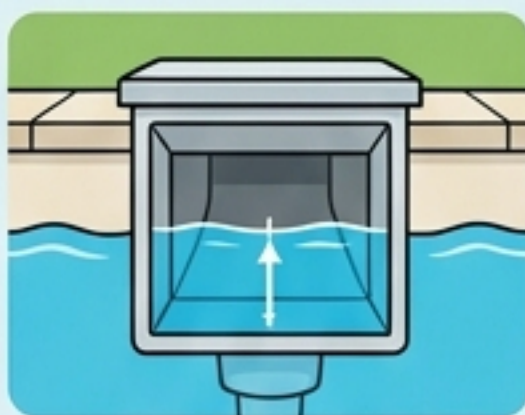


DAILY (The 5-Minute Skim)



Debris

Empty the skimmer baskets to maintain proper water flow.



Water Level

Do a quick visual check. Ensure the water is sitting at the midpoint of the skimmer face.



Surface

Scoop out floating leaves and bugs before they sink to the bottom.



WEEKLY (The 30-Minute Assist)



Brush:

Brush the walls and steps to prevent microfilm and algae from taking hold.



Pump:

Check and clear out the pump basket.

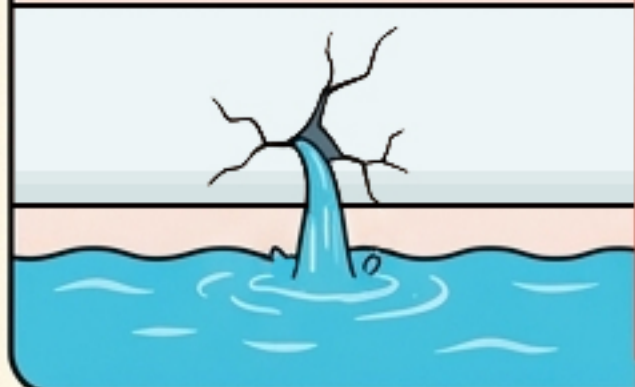


Pressure:

Check the filter pressure gauge. Note if it rises 8-10 PSI above your clean baseline.

WHEN TO CALL THE PROS

Substantial or sudden water loss (potential leak).



Loud grinding, screeching, or buzzing noises coming from the pump equipment.



Water quality issues that don't clear up after 48 hours of filtering.
