CURBSIDE RECYCLING: HOW TO SORT FOR CURBSIDE PICKUP

From New Orleans, LA., Dept. of Sanitation

Rinse all food container items before placing in recycling carts. Curbside: sorting is not required. Recycled material should be loose in carts - not in bags.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Paper – Cardboard –Metals – Plastics #1 & #2 (PET & HDPE)



1). PLASTICS

Recycle:

Plastics #1 (soda/water bottles) and #2 (milk/juice/shampoo/detergent containers etc.)

[Plastics #3-#7 are not recyclable]

2). CARDBOARD

Recycle:

- 6, 12, and 24-pack PAPER drink cartons
 (flattened)
- Paper egg cartons
- Shoe boxes
- Corrugated and paperboard boxes Flatten corrugated boxes and place in bin or on ground next to bin.

Do Not Recycle:

- NO pizza boxes
- NO plastic or foam packing material
- NO wax board (juice boxes/milk cartons)
- NO plastic bags

3). PAPER Recycle these Curbside:

- Junk mail
- Coupons
- White or colored paper
- Gift Wrap
- Envelopes
- Paper Grocery Bags
- Paper Shopping Bags
- Catalogs
- Magazines
- Newspapers and inserts Remove rubber bands and plastic bags. Don't tie up newspapers.
- Paperback books
- Telephone books

Do Not Recycle:

- NO soiled paper
- NO shredded paper
- NO photos
- NO hard cover books
- NO carbon paper
- NO newspaper delivery bags
- NO rubber bands
- NO plastic bags

4). METAL

Recycle:

 Small aluminum and steel cans Empty and rinse all metal containers before recycling.

Do Not Recycle:

- NO aerosol cans
- NO wire hangers
- NO non-food metal containers
- NO ferrous metal containers

5). BOXBOARD

Recycle:

- Soft drink boxes (rinse)
- Cereal and cracker boxes (remove liners)

Do Not Recycle:

- NO waxy frozen food packaging
- NO take-out food containers
- NO pizza boxes
- NO wax board
- NO plastic bags

6). GLASS

There is **no curbside** recycling of glass in the City residential recycling program. Residents **should not** put glass bottles in their recycling carts.

Residents can bring up to 50 lbs. of glass to the Elysian Fields recycling drop-off on the second and fourth Saturday of each month for recycling. https://www.nola.gov/sanitation/

WASTE ONLY



Items <u>Not Eligible</u> For Curbside Recycling

- Plastics #3 #7 (all go to the landfill)
- Plastic Bags
- <u>Wax</u> board (juice boxes/milk cartons)
- Glass
- Styrofoam
- Pizza boxes
- Food-contaminated containers
- Plastic bags
- Bubble wrap
- Plastic film
- Plastic wrap
- 6-pack rings
- Household garbage
- Yard trimmings
- Woody waste
- Building materials
- Household waste
- Hazardous waste (electronics, batteries, paint, chemicals, oil or oil filters
- Soiled papers (diapers, tissues, paper towels, paper plates, napkins, pizza boxes)
- Clothes hangers

- Chemical containers
- Packing materials

Even though some plastic items may have a recycling logo, if they are not 1 or 2 they are not accepted by the New Orleans' residential recycling program.

What Can You Do To Reduce Plastic Pollution?

1). Do not buy or use <u>single-use</u> plastic products (plastic straws, plastic utensils, plastic grocery bags, Styrofoam containers).

2). Request paper bags (reuse), paper straws, etc.

3). Support a legislative ban on single use plastic products.

4). Express your concerns to businesses and support a substitute for non-recyclable plastic products.

5). Ask your grocery store to stop the use of plastic bags. Take your own eco-friendly bags to carry groceries.

6). Support a more comprehensive recycling program. Reduce your purchase of over-packaged products.
