#### **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

Dear Neighbors,

2025 has been another great year to live in Arden Oaks, thanks in part to the Arden Oaks Neighborhood Association (AONA) sponsoring three well-attended, successful events.

At our Annual Meeting in March, Sacramento County Supervisor Rich Desmond joined us to share updates on several important topics including local road improvement and development projects. Phase 1 of the Arden Way Complete Street Project is now well underway, with upgrades taking place between Morse and Watt Avenues. We also heard from representatives of the Arden Oaks Security Program, which continues to strengthen safety in our neighborhood. Patrol coverage has been optimized through a combination of Sacramento County off-duty sheriff deputies and a private security firm, providing more consistent monitoring of the neighborhood.

This year's celebration was especially lively, with an estimated 200 friends and neighbors joining in the parade through the neighborhood and the games at Windemere Park. I'm fairly certain we broke a record for the number of folks participating in the balloon toss! Our fall BBQ event was a fantastic success! We enjoyed perfect weather, a great turnout, and exceptional food — served by your dedicated Board members. Hosted by Jim and Kathleen Deeringer, this year's barbecue featured freshly prepared Mediterranean dishes from nearby Babylon City Market, face painting for the kids, an ice cream sundae bar, and live music by Random Lane's Bob Stanley and friends. As a courtesy, AONA provides all new neighborhood homeowners a New Resident Handbook, which we hope all the families listed above have already received. The handbook contains valuable information about the Neighborhood Association, our Security Program, and the neighborhood events that we sponsor. It also includes a brief history of Arden Oaks, along with sections of the Sacramento County Zoning Code specifically relevant to our neighborhood. In addition, it explains the Neighborhood Preservation Area (NPA) development standards, County right-of-way rules, and other zoning requirements applicable to the Arden Oaks NPA.

#### **SECURITY REPORT**

In 2025, the AONA Security Program continued to provide on-the-ground, patrol monitoring of our neighborhood. This coverage was made possible through the combined services of off-duty deputies from the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office and the professional staff of a private security firm. Together, they have provided an average of over 70 hours of security patrol each month this year, with patrols occurring at random times of the day on nearly a daily basis.

During patrol shifts, the deputies or security staff drive clearly marked patrol vehicles through all the residential streets in Arden Oaks from Watt Avenue to Eastern Avenue and also walk the perimeter of Windemere Park, including the playground area. Patrol hours vary daily and can occur any time, including overnight, to ensure a consistent and visible presence. As we have done in years past, we will be increasing the number of patrol hours to the extent possible during the coming holiday season.

By and large, the patrol reports have noted nothing unusual or suspicious in the neighborhood, but their presence has clearly made a difference. In the past six months, patrols have encountered and escorted out a few individuals who did not belong in the neighborhood, ensuring they left the area. Deputies have also responded to residents' requests from neighbors investigating a false alarm, assisting neighbors, and even reuniting a lost dog with its owner.

In addition to route monitoring, the patrols conducted numerous vacation checks in response to specific requests and they moved conspicuously placed packages to safer locations when needed. Sheriff deputies also monitored for traffic violations within Arden Oaks, occasionally issuing warning for problems such as driving at night without headlights or expired registration.

If you see a patrol car while you're out walking the neighborhood, please take a moment to wave or say hello — the security team enjoys connecting with the residents. We are fortunate to live in a very safe neighborhood, and the AONA Security Program continues to play an important role in maintaining that safety. That said, there have been a few isolated reports of theft and burglary in recent months. We encourage all residents to review the security and safety tips available on our website at ArdenOaks.org under the Security tab, for ways you can protect yourself, your neighbors, and your property.

The continued success of this program depends entirely on the generous contributions of Arden Oaks residents. We extend our thanks to everyone who has supported the program this year. Please see the list at the end of this newsletter recognizing those who contributed in 2025.

#### SECURITY CONTACT INFORMATION

- Call 911 for Emergencies. If an off-duty sheriff deputy is patrolling Arden Oaks at the time of your call, the call will be assigned to them. Otherwise, an on-duty deputy will respond.
- Report Suspicious Activity or Concerns. Call the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office non-emergency line at 916-874-5115 to make a report.
- Crime Reporting. Victims of vandalism, mail or property theft, or illegal dumping, should file a crime report at sacsheriff.com/pages/crime\_report.php. The online report takes less than five minutes to submit, and reporting crimes helps ensure adequate sheriff patrols in Arden Oaks, both on- and off-duty.
- Request Vacation Monitoring. If you plan to be away for an extended period, the off-duty sheriff can
  monitor your property during their patrols. To request this service, email AO4@sacsheriff.com with
  your name, address, contact details, dates of absence, and any access instructions (e.g., gate codes).
  You can also call or text 916-612-9410, the dedicated Arden Oaks line, and provide the same
  information.
- Contact Patrolling Off-duty Sheriff Deputy. Call or text 916-612-9410 to inform them of any neighborhood concerns or issues.
