## ANNUAL NEIGHBORHOOD BARBECUE TO BE ON SEPTEMBER 12

The Board is delighted to bring back the annual neighborhood barbecue this year, after the unfortunate cancellation last year due to covid. This Arden Oaks tradition is free to all residents and is a wonderful opportunity for neighbors to gather, meet each other, and share a meal, all while listening to live music. It's like a block party but for the whole neighborhood! Tom and Nancy Harvey are once again hosting the event in their front yard at 2000 Rockwood. Live music will be provided by According to Bazooka, a Sammie-award winning four-piece combo with two women (one on bass and one on accordion) and two men (one on drums and one on guitar).

This year, we are taking extra precautions with covid variants still persisting. Besides being entirely outdoors, the barbecue will be serving individually boxed meals and individual servings of all drinks. Jackson Catering will be preparing hot entrées for adults and children. #### **SAC COUNTY 311 CONNECT**

Is there a dead tree limb in the roadway hovering precariously near your house? It's easy to contact Sacramento County and they will take care of it! The County has a very simple three-digit number — 311 — to call for non-emergency issues in unincorporated areas such as Arden Oaks. The service representatives are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to assist with any of the available service requests offered by the County. Examples of the types of services include: missed trash pick-up, ditch and culvert cleaning, tree or tree limb removal request.

#### **SECURITY REPORT**

During June, July, and August, the security patrol program continued as usual, with an average of 25 to 30 shifts per month. Each shift is four hours long, with starting times varying throughout the day from early morning to late night. This period was by and large uneventful, and the deputies reported only one incident (described below).

On average, the patrol officers conducted about four vacation checks each day in response to requests by contributing members of the security program. During the vacation checks, the deputies walk around the property, check for any problems, and call the designated person if any problem is noted. No incidents of vacation problems were reported. Most of the time, all of the vacation check properties were secure, but every once in a while, the officers will find the property not completely secure, such as an unlocked garage, window, or fence gate. In these instances, the deputies contacted the homeowners to help secure the property while they are away.

On average, the patrol officers received 4 to 5 contacts from residents during each shift, either through emails, texts, phone calls, or simply by being waved down during a shift. Most of these residents contact the officers because of concerns of suspicious people who don't look like they belong in the neighborhood or look like they are homeless. The patrol officers have been proactive about keeping the homeless out of Arden Oaks, mainly through ongoing contact with the Homeless Outreach program.

#### Here is the officer's first hand account of the one reported incident that occurred during this period:

I started the shift off by seeing multiple missed calls within 30 minutes prior to starting my shift. As I was trying to listen to the messages I received another call from the resident who was following a suspicious subject wandering through the area and walking onto peoples yards. I located the subject near La Playa and Village Lane. The subject was heavily under the influence of multiple narcotics and probably had been huffing spray paint. The subject also had a felony warrant for burglary and probation revocation. I took the subject into custody and booked him into jail. It did not appear the subject did any damage and did not have any property on him belonging to any of our residents. After I cleared the jail I spoke with the resident who had called our cell phone and reminded the resident to call the Sheriff's Office directly for emergencies and to only use the number to pass on information, vacation request and other non time-sensitive information.

#### **PEDESTRIAN SAFETY TIPS**

Among the many charms of Arden Oaks is the absence of sidewalks, allowing us to have more greenery, trees, and shade. However, pedestrians (walkers, joggers, strollers, etc.) should keep in mind the following safety guidelines:

- Walk facing traffic (left side of the street).
- Keep alert at all times, and when a car approaches, make sure the driver sees you.
- Watch for cars entering or exiting driveways.
- When you walk at night, wear reflective materials and/or carry a light.



#### **SMUD PROPOSED RATE CHANGES**

SMUD is proposing rate increases of about 1.5% in 2022 and 2% in 2023 plus a new solar and storage rate for customers that add rooftop solar energy generation to their homes. The proposed rate increases are well below the forecasted rate of inflation. This rate increase is needed for wildfire prevention and mitigation, infrastructure improvements to maintain reliability, compliance with clean energy requirements.
