

To the attention of the employer,

My patient tells me that you require a medical certificate of good health from him while he is back in Quebec following a trip or after completing a period of isolation. I am unable to issue such a certificate under the circumstances.

In the current context, we must focus our activities on priority issues. You and your employee must follow public health recommendations. I will not issue such a certificate. My colleagues and I simply do not have the time to spend on these types of requests. It's not relevant. It is important to know that if your employee does not have any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 (cough, fever/temperature, breathing difficulties), no medical certificate is required. If, on the contrary, he or she does have any of these symptoms, he or she will not go to work anyway.
