Call to Confession and Confession of Sin

P When trials come, we often resist the work God is doing within us. God calls us to perseverance, to trust Him in every test. Let us confess our sins, trusting the God who forms us through grace.

(A Time for Silent Reflection)

P: Trusting in God's grace, let us confess our sin together.

All: **Faithful God, we confess that when trials come, we do not count them as joy. We grumble instead of trusting, we rush for relief instead of perseverance, and we resist the work You are doing in us. Forgive us for doubting Your purpose, for giving up too quickly, and for forgetting that You are shaping us into maturity through every test. Renew our faith, strengthen our endurance, and teach us to trust You fully until Your work in us is complete. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.**

Assurance of Pardon

P: As we gather to as one body and one people before God, we worship Christ Jesus our Lord and savior. He is the only Son of God who humbly stepped from heaven, coming to earth to bring forgiveness to us all. He paid the debt for our sin once and for all on the cross and victoriously rose again from the grave, giving us the certainty of our forgiveness and pardon of sin, from our first day faith in Him until we one day He calls us home.


