God's work was never designed to be at a stand still and we pray that you will partner with us as He continues to work in and through Cypress Fellowship.

Cypress Fellowship's History

Cypress Fellowship was established in 2002

With a handful of families Cypress Fellowship met at Arnold Middle School which meant there was lots of packing and unpacking each week. Sundays were trailers and hard work, but the gospel of Jesus Christ was preached in the small cafeteria until we were able to have our own small space.

First Shopping Center Space

We found a space that we prayed we would make rent for each month and thankfully we did for awhile until we finally outgrew this space and had to find a place that would allow us to have a bigger areas for our babies, children and our teens. Our rent was higher, but we saw so much spiritual growth along with more families coming to church for the first time ever.

Second Shopping Center Space

The space we found was great. However by 2013 our rent began at 15,000 and we were looking at our rent increasing to about 17,000-20,000 monthly. Which was far higher than purchasing our own land. Our attendance numbers were higher, our ministries were flourishing, and God's work was being accomplished every day.

Cypress Rosehill Purchase

To own our own land seemed like such an impossibility back in 2002 but today we are now sitting on 10.3 acres. Purchased in 2013 at \$770,000. Today the current County Appraised Value is \$942,543.

We have the land and we have some additions but there is much more still to be done.

The Need

Well Permit Fee

To be able to install the well a permit is required. This cost is a set fee and not negotiable. \$8,350.00



We were able to obtain our Septic Permit to finally get a septic system installed so that our bathrooms in the Church space could be usable. We have quotes currently under consideration. Once this portion is complete, we can then open the bathrooms with limited water pressure. \$23,000



We're working on getting multiple quotes on this but so far, the estimate given to us by the engineer group is what we have here. \$240,000

Commercial Well

A commercial well will allows to have better water pressure. The size of the well is dependent on the amount of space needed to use water. \$30,000

Water Tank, fire sprinklers, dry hydrant and diesel fire pump

This will keep us compliant for fire safety. \$142,000

Approx. current financial need: \$480,000


