

IRA TOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT WARNING
Annual School District Meeting

March 2 and March 3, 2026

The legal voters of the Ira Town School District are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Ira Town Hall in said Town at seven o'clock in the evening on Monday March 2, 2026, for a public informational hearing to discuss articles 1 & 2, and to recess to Tuesday, March 3, 2026 at 10:00 AM (polls open) through 7:00 PM (polls close) to act on articles 3 through 4 by Australian Ballot at the Ira Town Office.

March 2, 2026

- Article 1. To hear the reports of the School Board and other District officials and act thereon.
- Article 2. To transact any other lawful business that comes before the meeting.

March 3, 2026

- Article 3. "Shall the voters of the Ira School District approve the school board to expend \$852,788.14, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Ira Town School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$9,871, which is 3.5% higher than the per pupil education spending for the current year."
- Article 4. To elect school officers as required by law:
- School Moderator for a term of one (1) year.
 - School Director for a term of three (3) years.

Said persons and voters are further warned and notified that pursuant to 17 V.S.A. Section 2680(h), Article 3 constitutes a Public Hearing on the proposed budget.
