Review and Discuss **Article 3:** Shall the voters authorize the total expenditure of \$332,171 for the Town General Fund and Highway Fund for the fiscal year 7/1/24 – 6/30/25, for which \$246,335.13 shall be raised by taxes and \$85,835.87 by non-property tax revenue?

Review and Discuss **Article 4:** Shall the voters appropriate \$13,917.11 to be raised by taxes for the Rutland County Sheriff's Department, in addition to \$12,000 included in the General Fund expenditures in Article 3 above for a total of \$25,917.11?

Review and Discuss **Article 5:** Shall the voters appropriate \$39,750 for the support of the Ira Volunteer Fire Department to provide services to the residents of Ira?
