Ira, VT – A Regional Concerns Meeting on the project listed below will be held on Tuesday, June 20th, beginning at 6:00 PM during the regularly scheduled selectboard meeting at the Ira Town Offices, located at 53 West Road in Ira, VT. The meeting will be held by the Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) and Town of Ira.

Bridge replacement project:

- Ira STP CULV(124) – Bridge 14 on VT Route 4A over Ira Brook

The selected alternative is a replacement with a new buried structure while maintaining traffic on an offsite detour for 28 days during construction.

The intent of the meeting is to provide an overview of this bridge project to Town Officials, local residents and businesses, emergency services and other interested parties. There will be a review of the existing site conditions, proposed work, and overall schedule followed by a question-and-answer period. Representatives from both VTrans and the Town of Ira will be available at the meeting to address public concerns about the project.
