Review and Discuss **Article 3:** Shall the voters authorize the total expenditure of \$323,247 for the Town General Fund and Highway Fund for the fiscal year 7/1/25 – 6/30/26, for which \$222,680.01 shall be raised by taxes and \$100,566.69 by non-property tax revenue?

Review and Discuss **Article 4:** Shall the voters appropriate \$12,000 to be raised by taxes for the Rutland County Sheriff's Department?

Review and Discuss **Article 5:** Shall the voters appropriate \$38,650 for the support of the Ira Volunteer Fire Department to provide services to the residents of Ira?

Review and Discuss **Article 6:** Shall the voters appropriate \$15,000 to the Ira Volunteer Fire Department to go into the reserve fund for the purpose of replacing a fire truck?
