The town will rent his equipment when needed instead of hiring him as a sub-contractor with his equipment. Alan May met with Jeff and looked over the roads. Alan said the guard rails on Toppin Road are adequate for the location. Jeff will fix the guard rail. Discussed where winter road maintenance and road work is to end on the town's dead end roads, where they transition to class 4 and roads of other towns and where the town truck is to turn around.
