ACT ONE

FADE IN:

INT. BOB'S BURGER'S - DAY

BOB and LINDA are behind the counter, there's not a customer in sight.

LINDA

That customer was back.

BOB

Good.

LINDA

Not good, Bob.

BOB

Not good?

LINDA

No, he drives me crazy. He comes in here all the time and turns the toilet roll paper the wrong way.

BOB

There's a wrong way?

LINDA

Yeah, he makes it hang down the back, so it wipes our greasy walls before wiping our customers' butts.

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Our walls are greasy?

LINDA

Yes, Bob. I hate those, backwardsfacing toilet roll freaks.

BOB

Hate is such a strong word.

LINDA

Well, if I ever find out who he is,
I'm going to ban him from the
restaurant.

BOB

We can't ban him from the restaurant, we need the money.

LINDA

Money's more important than my mental health?

BOB

There's nothing wrong with your mental health.

LINDA

(FRUSTRATED GROWL) I'm going for a mental health walk, Bob.

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Linda takes off her apron and leaves.

BOB

Okay, I guess I'll just run the restaurant by myself then.

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY

Linda walks by the new shop next door, 'ROB'S BURGERS'. She stops right outside the door unaware, as TINA goes to walk by her on the street.

LINDA

Tina, where are you going?

Tina stops and looks at Linda confused.

TINA

Err...

LINDA

Tina, it's Mom.

TINA

Oh, hi. I didn't recognize you without your apron on.

LINDA

Really? Aww, thanks, sweetie.

Shouldn't you be at school?

TINA

Yes, but I forgot to wear pants.

LINDA

You did?

Zoom out to REVEAL Tina without pants on.

LINDA (CONT'D)

Oh yeah, you did.

TINA

Damn it.

TEDDY walks out of Rob's Burgers, rubbing his tummy and licking his lips. He sees Linda and Tina, then backs into 'Rob's Burgers' unnoticed.

LINDA

You got all the way to school like

that and didn't notice?

TTNA

I had no idea.

LINDA

Huh.

TINA

Okay, bye, Mom.

LINDA

Bye, sweetie. Good luck.

Tina walks off in the direction of Bob's Burgers, and Linda continues to the park. Teddy spies out of the window, and makes a break for it, running towards Bob's.

EXT. PARK - DAY

Linda enters the park and sees a shaded area beneath a tree. Linda lies down on the grass.

LINDA

This is nice.

Linda has her arms and legs spread out, looking at the clouds; one looks like a burger, one looks like a toilet roll, and the other looks like Bob.

ROB, a younger and sexier version of Bob, and the owner of Rob's Burgers, leans into view. He is silhouette-like, his face somewhat obscured by the sun behind him.

LINDA (CONT'D)

Bob, is that you? (NERVOUSLY) Oh my. Bob, you look so handsome.

ROB

Close, my name is Rob.

Beat.

ROB (CONT'D)

Are you okay? Did you have a heart attack? You're laying on the floor in a dog park, and are most definitely covered in dog pee.

LINDA

Hey, I know you. You're that toilet roll guy. You turn my toilet rolls the wrong way.

ROB

Sorry, that's how they do it in Europe.

LINDA

Really? Fancy. Maybe I'll keep it that way.

Rob kneels beside Linda. He brushes the hair from Linda's face, and she stares into his eyes. Her heart melts.

ROB

(SEDUCTIVELY) You have the most beautiful eyes in the world.

LINDA

Married! I'm married, to a wonderful man who doesn't think I have mental health issues.

ROB

(AWKWARDLY) That's nice. May I sit down?

LINDA

It's a public park, I couldn't stop
you, not with all those muscles
(LAUGHS awkwardly).

Beat.

LINDA (CONT'D)

(SINGS) So many muscles, can't stop looking, although I'm married, he's so hot he's cooking.

Can't blame a woman, for being a fan, gonna get in trouble, for eye-banging this handsome man.

ROB

Er, I can hear you (LAUGHS).

Linda nervously and runs away.

LINDA

No, you can't!

Rob looks down at the ground and picks up Linda's shoe, Cinderella-style.

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY - ESTABLISHING

INT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY - CONTINUOUS

Teddy sits at the counter, and a couple of ELDERLY CUSTOMERS sit in a booth eating a burger.

TEDDY

My burger is still raw, Bob.

BOB

Huh? Sorry, I'm just a little
distracted because Linda has left
me--

TEDDY

Oh no, really? Do you think it's too soon for me to ask her out?

BOB

You want to ask out my wife?

TEDDY

Well, if she's single.

BOB

Hmm.

TEDDY

Slim pickings when you get to thirty?

BOB

You're only thirty?

TEDDY

No, it's been slim pickings for a while now.

BOB

Oh. Well, we're not getting a divorce, Teddy. She just went for a walk.

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TEDDY

Oh. (BEAT) What about my raw burger, Bob?

BOB

Just eat it. You can eat a rare steak, you should be able to eat a raw burger, right? They're both beef.

TEDDY

I guess.

Teddy takes a bite of the raw burger.

TEDDY (CONT'D)

This is not good, Bob. Is that blood, Bob? Is that—

Teddy passes out and falls off the bar stool.

Two HIPSTER MILLENNIALS walk in. They spot Teddy laying on the floor and ignore him.

HIPSTER MILLENNIAL #1

Do you have the Sirloin Steak
Burger with extra truffles?

BOB

What? No.

HIPSTER MILLENNIAL #2

Isn't this Rob's Burgers?

Er... No. It's Bob's Burgers.

Because my name is Bob. Do you want
to hear the specials?

HIPSTER MILLENNIAL #1

Pff... No.

They leave.

BOB

That, uh... was strange.

Teddy wakes up with a crotch stain.

TEDDY

(TO ELDERLY CUSTOMERS) Can I grab a couple of those napkins there? I seem to of spilled some juice on my pants.

ELDERLY CUSTOMER #1

Smells like urine. Did you pee your pants?

TEDDY

No.

BOB

Are you sure?

TEDDY

As sure as I am wide, Bobby.

ELDERLY CUSTOMER #1

What is it then?

TEDDY

Juice, I told you!

ELDERLY CUSTOMER #2

Doesn't smell like juice.

BOB

You didn't order any juice, Teddy.

Teddy takes off his pants and sniffs them, then licks them. He thinks and then licks them again.

TEDDY

Yep, definitely urine. I can tell by the taste.

BOB

How do you know what urine tastes like?

TEDDY

I spent three days in the Mohave desert when I was a kid. My parents accidentally left me there, when we went on vacation.

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That explains a lot.

TEDDY

What?

BOB

(BACK-TRACKING) I bet that was really hot.

TEDDY

Oh, it was. That's why I've been bald most of my life.

BOB

I've seen you with hair.

TEDDY

It was a wig, Bob!

BOB

That's, uh... too much information, Teddy.

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TEDDY

No, it's not. It's not like I'm gonna tell you how I made the wig from the hair of the sexiest woman on the planet, my mother, by collecting her hair over the years in my pillowcase, and then fastening it to my head using Gorilla glue.

BOB

(UNSURE) That's... creative?

Bob **strokes** his burger-shaped bald spot as if he's considering this.

TEDDY

Lasted about six months, but eventually, I had to start showering again.

Linda arrives at the restaurant, panting and out of breath.

LINDA

Bob!

BOB

Linda?

LINDA

Kiss me.

Here?

She **kisses** Bob in an uncomfortable public display of affection, bending him backwards over the counter and mounting him.

TEDDY

Why don't you rub your happiness in my face, Bob?

BOB

Are you missing a shoe?

LINDA

Never mind that you sexy man!

BOB

Linda, stop. People are looking.

A prim CUSTOMER pushes her half-eaten burger away with disgust.

TITNDA

Let them look.

CUSTOMER

Well, you've just cut your tip in half.

LINDA

(TO SPECTATORS) Do you wanna take a picture? It will last longer.

Teddy pulls out a camera and takes a photo.

Bob, tries to talk to Teddy, as Linda snogs his face off...

BOB

(MUMBLES) Teddy? I'm going to need

that photo.

Teddy attempts to run out of the restaurant clutching his camera.

Bob drops Linda on the floor and chases after Teddy.

TEDDY

Never! This is the sexiest photo

I've ever seen.

Bob sits on Teddy and grabs at the camera, as Teddy stretches his arm to keep it away from him.

BOB

Give it to me.

Bob tickles Teddy until he wins the camera.

TEDDY

Oh no, I peed again.

BOB

Oh, God.

LINDA

Grab a mop, Teddy.

BOB

Then once you're done cleaning with it, burn it.

TEDDY

Sure thing, Bob.

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

FADE IN:

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - NIGHT - ESTABLISHING

INT. DINNER TABLE - NIGHT

The Belcher family are eating dinner together. LOUISE, GENE, and Tina sit at the table, as Linda serves food.

Bob places Teddy's camera down on a kitchen counter.

LOUISE

Dad, I can't help but notice that you have a new camera, after telling me that we had no money for a horse that I wanted.

BOB

That's not why we don't have a horse, Louise.

TINA

Is it because I'm allergic to horses?

LINDA

(LYING) Yes, sweetie, you're totally allergic to all animals.

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LOUISE

That's not fair. Just because
Tina's allergic to horses, that
means I don't get a horse?

LINDA

If we ever win the lottery, we'll buy you two horses. How about that?

GENE

You play the lottery now? (FANCY)
La-di-dah.

BOB

No, it's a waste of money unless you win.

LOUISE

It's because you just don't want me to be happy!

Louise storms off into the bedroom.

LINDA

Maybe we should just buy her a horse teddy bear.

BOB

I don't see how that would help.

TINA

Well, this was fun.

Tina secretly snatches up Teddy's camera and slopes off to her bedroom.

INT. TINA'S BEDROOM - NIGHT

Louise barges into Tina's room, to find Tina posing awkwardly, an unsuccessful attempt at being seductive. She is fully dressed and awkwardly licking a ruler.

LOUISE

Can you believe Mom and Dad?

The camera timer goes off three times, FLASH-FLASH, as Tina holds the pose and Louise stares at Tina.

TINA

This isn't what it looks like.

LOUISE

Is that ruler made of chocolate?

TINA

No, it's just a ruler.

LOUISE

(RE: RULER) Can I try it?

Tina hands the ruler to Louise.

TTNA

Sure.

LOUISE

Just tastes like wood. I wanna say... pine.

TINA

I'm taking sexy photos for Jimmy Pesto Junior.

LOUISE

Why?

TINA

I want him to see me as more than a friend.

LOUISE

Like what, a person who eats stationery?

TINA

Well, no, but I borrowed a women's magazine from Aunt Gayle, and it said that you should show your love interest your sexier side.

LOUISE

Let me help.

TINA

Why?

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LOUISE

Because you're going to do my chores for the next two weeks, so I figured it's the least I can do.

TINA

No, the least you can do is nothing. But, I accept your help.

LOUISE

So, where is that sexy magazine belonging to Aunt Gayle?

TTNA

In my newest, secretest, hiding
place. Close your eyes and I'll get
it.

LOUISE

(UNSURE) Okay.

Tina starts moving around the room, trying to disorientate Louise.

LOUISE (CONT'D)

You know I can hear you.

TTNA

Not if I make my super-cool secret hiding place theme music;

(MORE)

TINA (CONT'D)

boop-de-boop, la-la-la, boom-shacka-

lacka-shacka-lacka-shacka-boom.

Tina recovers the magazine that was balanced over the bar of a coat hanger, covered by a blazer, inside her closet.

She continues making her SUPER-COOL SECRET HIDING PLACE THEME MUSIC...

TINA (CONT'D)

Bal-la-la-way, Na-nah-na-nah. Ca-

caw, ca-caw.

... as she makes her way to the window, as a ruse.

TINA (CONT'D)

There.

LOUISE

Definitely didn't see your closet

hiding place, Tina.

TINA

Good.

Bob's yelling can be heard from downstairs.

BOB (O.S.)

Get out! Get out! Get out!

Tina and Louise run into Gene's room...

INT. GENE'S BEDROOM - DAY

Gene sits on his bed playing his keyboard. Louise and Tina run to the window and look down at Bob, who chases a couple of CUSTOMERS away with his broom.

Gene arrives at the window, and the three kids spy on Bob.

And don't come back!

Gene arrives at the window.

LOUISE

The last one downstairs is a rotten

egg.

The three kids run out of the room and get stuck in the doorway. Then, scrappy Louise breaks through first, but Gene and Tina get stuck again.

LOUISE (CONT'D)

Later losers.

INT. BOB'S BURGER'S - DAY

Gene and Tina burst into the restaurant.

LOUISE

What took you so long?

GENE

We came as fast as we could.

TINA

I had to wait until Gene released

some gas, so I could break free.

GENE

Dad! Do we have rats again?

A FAMILY sat in a booth, put down their menus, and leave in a panic.

Gene. We don't mention the rats.

LINDA

Oh, the cute little rat babies.

GENE

Dad, but I like the rats. They remind me of naked hampsters with long tails.

TINA

Did you say hampsters, with a P?

GENE

No... I said HAMPSTERS!

BOB

Linda, your gonna have to find Gene a new friend. If he keeps playing with vermin, he's eventually going to get rabies and die.

LINDA

Aww, Genie. Maybe we can hang out more? Would you like to hang out with Mommy?

GENE

I would love that, Mom!

LINDA

We can try 'Mom and Baby yoga'.

Would you like that, Genie?

ANGLE ON: Gene and Linda rub their noses together, over-affectionately.

LINDA (CONT'D)

Where are the girls?

REVEAL the door closing, suggesting that Tina and Louise have left.

INT. TINA'S BEDROOM - DAY

Laying on Tina's bed, reading the women's magazine.

LOUISE

Says here that men like vulnerable women. Maybe if we take a photograph of you crying, Jimmy Junior will think that you are sexy.

TINA

I can't cry.

LOUISE

What if I said that you were ugly and stupid?

TINA

I would agree.

LOUISE

No! You're supposed to cry.

TINA

How?

LOUISE

Avoid blinking. (BEAT) Think of something sad. (BEAT) Yawn!

TINA

I don't think it is working.

Louise slaps Tina.

LOUISE

Make your eyes wet now!

TINA

I can't do it!

LOUISE

(a nod to Dan Mintz)

You sound like a man!

TINA

(a nod to John Roberts)

If I sound like a man, so does Mom.

LOUISE

(FRUSTRATED GROWL) Wait there a minute.

Louise leaves the room, and Tina stands in the middle of the room, literally doing nothing.

Louise arrives with a bottle of lemon juice and squirts it directly into Tina's eyes.

TINA

(RE: LEMON JUICE) Oww! It burns.

What the hell?!

Tina rubs her eyes, her face is red and blotchy, an ugly mess. She blinks hard.

TINA (CONT'D)

Everything is yellow. Is that

normal?

LOUISE

How would I know?

TINA

Did it work? (BLINKS HARD) Am I

beautiful now?

LOUISE

Jeez, Tina, you're an ugly crier.

No wonder why you don't do it in

public.

Louise snaps photographs of Tina, getting closer and closer to her. CLICK-CLICK.

Linda enters the bedroom.

LINDA

What's going on here?

LOUISE

Nothing. Just taking some photos of Tina to send Jimmy Junior.

LINDA

Tina, you don't have to pimp yourself out for a boy like some... floozy? (RE: PHOTOS) Let me see those.

Linda grabs the camera from Louise, and looks through them:

SERIES OF PHOTOGRAPHS, that are more awkward than sexy:

- Tina recreating the FOOTLOOSE chair scene,
- Tina kneeling on the corner of her bed recreating the TITANIC "King of the World" pose,
- Tina wearing an apron and spinning, her arms outward, recreating the SOUND OF MUSIC.
- Tina's head pushing through her doorway, recreating THE SHINING "Here's Johnny" scene.

END SERIES OF PHOTOGRAPHS.

LINDA (CONT'D)

Oh, is this what you girls were doing, taking strange photos of movie scenes? I'm relieved. I thought you were taking your clothes off. (LAUGHS UNCOMFORTABLY) Have fun girls.

Linda backs out of the room, leaving the girls with the camera.

Tina and Louise look at each other, they have a great idea...

LOUISE

Are you thinking what I'm thinking?

TINA (SIMULTANEOUS)

A single sneeze travels at 100 miles an hour.

LOUISE (SIMULTANEOUS)

Naked photos.

TINA

(BACK-TRACKING) Yes, that's what I said naked photos. Wait. Naked photos?

LOUISE

Maybe you and Jimmy Pesto Junior can build one of those unlikely animal friendships together, like the one with the dog and the goose. You're the goose.

TINA

I can be a goose.

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY - ESTABLISHING

INT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY

TWO GOTHS are standing at the counter. They are wearing all black, with black make-up, and refuse to smile. When they talk, they are monotone and unenthusiastic.

BOB

(FRUSTRATED) You're the fifth person to ask me about Rob's Burgers this week. What is it with this Rob's Burger place?

GOTH #1

It's only the best burger place in town.

BOB

You want a burger, why don't you just eat here?

They look around and scoff.

GOTH #2

(SCOFFS) As if! Come on, Babe.

GOTH #1 (SCOFFS) Okay, Babe.

BOB

I'm sure you don't mean to insult me.

GOTH #1

Oh, we did.

Get out of here you Zoomers!

TEDDY

Zoomers, Bob?

BOB

Yeah, the lazy generation of kids that zoom around on electric scooters and those wheel things with no handles.

The customers turn back in the doorway and scoffs again.

GOTH #1

(SCOFFS) Look how his mustache shakes when he's mad.

BOB

Get out of here!

Bob chases the customers out of the restaurant with a broom and follows them out.

BOB (CONT'D)

And for the record, my mustache shakes the right amount!

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY

The two goth-looking customers run into Rob's next door... 'ROB'S BURGERS', and Bob finally sees the sign.

(TO HIMSELF) What the--? Rob's

Burgers?!

Bob cups his face and looks through the window, his mustache shaking furiously.

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT TWO

ACT THREE

FADE IN:

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY - ESTABLISHING

INT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY

Bob slams open the door to his restaurant, looking angrier than we've ever seen him.

BOB

Can you believe that guy? Opening a burger place right next door.

TEDDY

It's been there all month. Don't you ever go outside?

BOB

Why would I, Teddy? I have everything I need here. Food is delivered right to our door, and we live right upstairs.

TEDDY

The door to your apartment is right next door to Rob's--

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I work a sixty-hour week, Teddy.

Then I sleepwalk home and start all over again. (BEAT) Who's side are you on Teddy?!

TEDDY

Yours, Bob.

BOB

Did you eat there, Teddy? Did you?

TEDDY

Err, no... I... Only once. And I got food poisoning and fell off a bar stool.

BOB

That was here, this morning.

TEDDY

I'm sure it wasn't that raw burger you made me eat.

BOB

Made you eat?! Maybe I should make you eat another five more?

Gene, Louise, and Tina, all arrive to witness Bob dive at Teddy. Bob and Teddy tumble to the staff side of the counter.

LOUISE

Get him, Dad!

Bob reaches through the pass-through window into the kitchen and grabs a handful of raw meat, then forces it into Teddy's mouth.

BOB

Something wrong with my meat,

Teddy?!

TEDDY

(GAGGING) No, Bob. Your meat is

delicious.

BOB

Say it again!

TEDDY

(GAGGING) Your meat is delicious!

LINDA

Bob, leave him alone. He's sorry.

Say you're sorry, Teddy.

TEDDY

(CRYING) I'm sorry, Teddy.

Bob realizes that he was harsh and straightens up. When Teddy sits up his eyes are watering.

GENE

(TO TEDDY) Are you crying?

TINA

I wish I could cry.

TEDDY

(MOUTH FULL OF RAW BEEF) No.
There's raw onion in there, Bob.

BOB

Well, okay then.

Linda kisses Bob.

LINDA

Look at my sexy man having his first fight. You're like a sexy John L. Sullivan.

BOB

I don't know who that is.

LINDA

He was a boxer, with a sexy mustache. He's dead now.

GENE

I want to be a boxer... sitting on people and feeding them raw beef.

BOB

I don't know what came over me. I'm sorry you guys had to see that.

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Everyone, including people outside, stares at Bob through the restaurant window.

LINDA

Well, I thought it was sexy. The only thing that would make you even sexier, would be if you were in your underwear and covered in mud.

Louise balks.

LOUISE

(BALKS) Ahhh, Mom! Don't ruin this for me. I finally see Dad as a man.

TINA

If you didn't see Dad as a man, what did you see him as?

GENE

A big hairy gorilla!

BOB

Err, thanks.

LOUISE

I see Dad as a second Mom.

LINDA

But without the mustache, right sweetie?

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LOUISE

Sure, Mom. (AIR QUOTATIONS) You don't have a mustache.

LINDA

(RE: RAW BEEF) Teddy, maybe you should spit that out now.

TEDDY

I don't want to. (BALKING) My best friend Bob made this and it's delicious. It's the best burger I've ever eaten.

BOB

Actually, Teddy, that is just plain beef out of the packet. I haven't even added spices or done anything to it yet.

TEDDY

I don't care, Bob. I'm gonna finish it. It's such an honour to eat this-

Teddy projectile vomits all over the floor.

TEDDY (CONT'D)

(VOMITS)

LOUISE

I am not cleaning that up.

GENE

Me neither.

TINA

I'll do it. Can I do it, please?

BOB

Don't let me stop you. (TO TEDDY)

Let me help you up.

Bob slips in Teddy's **vomit**, and they stand up and fall again. They are covered in **vomit**.

BOB (CONT'D)

Linda, help me!

LINDA

Hard pass. (BEAT) Well, I don't know about you, but I'm going over to Rob's Burgers, and seeing what the fuss is all about.

GENE

Ooo, Mom is a spy now.

TINA

Do you need to borrow my black leotard?

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I'm not going to abseil through their skylight, in the middle of the night, Tina.

LOUISE

No, but that would be awesome.

LINDA

If I could fit through that small window, it would be, yeah.

BOB

A little help, Linda?

LINDA

Nah, before you were sexy... but the moment's passed.

Linda leaves.

BOB

Kids?

LOUISE

Sorry, Dad. Homework.

Louise takes off.

GENE

No, Dad, don't clean it up just yet.

BOB

Why not, Gene?

Gene takes off his shirt.

GENE

Can't we mud wrestle in it first?

Gene slips in the vomit.

вов

(GROANS)

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT THREE

ACT FOUR

FADE IN:

EXT. ROB'S BURGERS - DAY

A queue of people lines up around the block to enter 'Rob's Burgers'. Linda walks to the back of the queue, where Rob is handing out free bottles of water.

He sees Linda.

ROB

You.

LINDA

You.

Linda blushes.

ROB

Take my arm. I have a special booth with your name on it.

Linda surprises herself with the sound of her giggle.

LINDA

(GIGGLES, TO HERSELF) Oh God, what was that?

ROB

I don't know, but I like it.

She giggles again, this time with a snort.

LINDA

(GIGGLE-SNORT)

INT. ROB'S BURGERS - DAY

The place is pristine, and much fancier than Bob's Burgers, but more than that the place is full of people.

A woman, MANDY, a young busty blonde, comes over...

MANDY

It's going to be a twenty-minute wait.

ROB

Don't worry, Mandy, this is my special guest, Linda.

Linda giggles again. WTF?

LINDA

(GIGGLES)

INT. ROB'S BURGERS - TABLE BY WINDOW - DAY

Rob pulls out a chair at a table beside the window, and Linda sits.

LINDA

Ooo, fancy. Look at these tablecloths.

ROB

(TRYING TO CHARM HER) The white the tablecloth, the fancier the restaurant.

LINDA

I see. We don't have any tablecloths in our restaurant.

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ROB

(SEXY WHISPER) Exactly.

MANDY

Can I start you off with some drinks, maybe some table water?

LINDA

Is it too early for wine?

MANDY (SIMULTANEOUS)

Yes.

ROB (SIMULTANEOUS)

Never.

LINDA

Then, yes to both wine and table water.

Rob leans close to Linda.

LINDA (CONT'D)

(TO MANDY) What's good here?

MANDY

All of it.

ROB

(SEXILY) Let me order for you. I have a delicious lamb burger that has your name on it.

Wow, I seem to have my name on a lot of things. (LAUGHS)

ROB

Indeed. (LAUGHS)

Rob places his hand on Linda's.

ROB (CONT'D)

I have something for you, close your eyes.

EXT. ROB'S BURGERS - DAY (CONTINUOUS)

Tina, Gene, and Louise walk to Rob's Burgers and see Linda sitting with Rob, her eyes closed. Wine is being poured and it looks as though they are enjoying a meal.

LOUISE

What the hell? Mom's cheating on Dad. Now who's being a floozy, Mom?

GENE

Don't jump to conclusions Louise.

LOUISE

Don't not jump to conclusions,

Gene. This man could be our new

dad!

TINA

I kinda like our old dad.

LOUISE

Me too. I don't have the time to get to know someone else.

GENE

I'd rather get a dog.

TINA

Is Dog-Dad an option here?

LOUISE

(WHISPERS TO ROB) Sorry, goodlooking guy with Mom, it's just not

meant to be.

Rob leans in for a kiss...

INT. ROB'S BURGERS - TABLE BY WINDOW - DAY (CONTINUOUS)

Rob's lips almost touch Linda's when Louise and Gene bang on the window looking concerned. Tina looks gormless.

LOUISE (SIMULTANEOUS)

MOM!!!

GENE (SIMULTANEOUS)

MOM!!!

Linda opens her eyes to see Rob about to kiss her.

She grabs the tablecloth to create a barrier between her and Rob. Everything **spills** and **crashes** to the ground like a Magician's Tablecloth Trick fail.

Oh my.

Linda runs out of the restaurant, still holding the tablecloth.

ROB

Stop, Linda!

Everything on surrounding tables crashes to the floor, as she makes her exit.

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY - ESTABLISHING

INT. BOB'S BURGERS - DAY

Rob enters.

ROB

Linda. You left this over at my place.

Rob wiggles his eyebrows at Bob, to make him jealous.

Bob doesn't react.

GENE

Home-wrecker!

LINDA

How did you find me?

ROB

It wasn't hard, considering you are right next door.

(MORE)

ROB (CONT'D)

And I ate here yesterday, to check out the competition. And we discussed toilet rolls.

LINDA

Oh, yeah.

ROB

Here are my repair costs. Plus, extra for emotional stress.

Bob looks at the bill, very expensive.

BOB

We're not paying for this.

ROB

You will, as soon as I get a lawyer.

BOB

A lawyer?

ROB

I'm planning on suing you for more than this dump is worth, so you and your tease of a wife will have to close up shop, permanently.

(CACKLES) And Linda, you'll never get your shoe back.

Rob turns to leave but only makes it to the door.

LOUISE

(TO TINA) I have an idea.

Louise wipes down the camera with a napkin.

LOUISE (CONT'D)

Before you go, would you mind taking a photo of us?

BOB

Now's not the time, Louise.

LOUISE

Please, Dad. It'll only take ten seconds.

ROB

Doesn't make sense, but sure.

Rob takes the photograph and Louise holds out a plastic Ziplock bag. Rob is confused but he drops it inside.

LOUISE

Cheers, Big Ears.

ROB

Whatever, see you all in court.

LOUISE

Yeah, you will!

Rob leaves.

BOB

That went... well.

INT. APARTMENT - BOB AND LINDA'S BEDROOM - NIGHT

Bob and Linda are laying in bed, unable to sleep.

LINDA

Do you think he's going to take our home and restaurant away?

BOB

I don't know, Linda, but we've had

a good run--

LINDA

No, we haven't.

BOB

(REALIZING) No, we haven't.

Tina knocks on the door and enters their bedroom, her eyes shielded.

TINA

Are you guys doing it?

LINDA

Doing what?

TINA

It.

Tina peeks through her fingers.

TINA (CONT'D)

Never mind.

Tina climbs onto her parents' bed.

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TINA (CONT'D)

Are we going to have to move?

LINDA

I don't know, Tina-Bo-Bina. But whatever happens, we'll all be together.

Gene bursts into their bedroom. Red and Blue lights flash behind him.

GENE

Ahh, Mom, I think I'm being abducted.

LINDA

What?

BOB

Go back to sleep, Gene.

TINA

I'm going to miss you, Gene.

GENE

There are flashing blue and red lights coming from outside my bedroom window.

LINDA

I see them too.

BOB

I'm gonna go and see. If I'm not back in ten minutes, you best not marry Rob.

LINDA

I won't.

BOB

(FIRMLY) I mean it.

LINDA

I promise. Not even if he begs.

BOB

If he begs? Hmm. You'd like that, wouldn't you?

EXT. BOB'S BURGERS - NIGHT

Rob is being hauled away by a couple of POLICE OFFICERS.

ROB

I don't know how that camera got there. It's not mine. It's theirs.

Theirs I tell you!

POLICE OFFICER #1

Are you telling me that they took seductive photographs of their own teenage daughter?

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POLICE OFFICER #2

There's zero tolerance for people in possession of child pornography.

ROB

What?!

ROB (CONT'D)

That's not mine. I have no idea how that got there.

Louise arrives, feigning a yawn.

LOUISE

(YAWN) What did I miss?

The Belcher family all look to Louise.

BOB

I... I think that all of our problems have just been solved.

LOUISE

Would you look at that...

Louise picks up Linda's shoe

LOUISE (CONT'D)

Hey, look what I found.

Louise hands Linda her shoe.

(SHOCK) Louise, where did you get this?

LOUISE

I'll take my payment in the form of a horse.

FADE TO BLACK.

END OF SHOW

CREDIT SCENE

Linda and Gene take up a SERIES OF AWKWARD 'MOM AND BABY YOGA POSES':

- BOAT POSE: Linda holds Gene's waist, who sits on her belly. She leans back, lifting her feet up.
- DOWNWARD-FACING DOG: Gene lays on his back, and Linda creates a triangle with her buttocks in the air. She maintains eye contact.
- COBBLER'S POSE: Linda sits on the floor, the soles of her feet flat together. Gene sits on her lap staring into each other's eyes.
- COBRA: Linda lays flat on her belly, as Gene sits on her back. She gently pushes up until her arms are straight, then tilts her head upwards to look at the ceiling.
- CORPSE POSE: Linda lies on her back, with Gene on her stomach. He rests his head on Linda's bosom.
