

Assistant Pastor James Godwin

Minister Richard Harris, a native of Mitchellville, MD, is a passionate servant leader committed to helping young people excel. He preached his initial sermon on March 7, 1999, and was licensed to preach by New Mount Nebo Baptist Church in Capitol Heights, MD.

Min. Harris currently serves as Director of Children and Youth Ministry at Watts Chapel Missionary Baptist Church in Raleigh, NC, under the leadership of Rev.

Dr. Harry Leo White, Jr. He also inspires minds as a teacher at Leesville Road Middle School, where he was named 2021–2022 Teacher of the Year and recognized as a Wake County Public School System Semi-Finalist.

A graduate of Howard University with a Bachelor of Arts in Business Management, he also holds a Christian Ministry Diploma, Youth Ministry Award, and Spiritual Fitness Award from Christian Leaders Institute.

Whether through ministry, education, or sports, his passion is helping young people grow into their God-given purpose.

His life is anchored in Proverbs 12:25: "Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, but a good word makes it glad."



Pastor Roland Ihaza (EE-Ha-Za)

Pastor Roland Ihaza was born in the African country of Nigeria to the late Richard and Grace Ihaza. He grew up in the small town of Ogbese, which is about 91 miles from the capital of Benin City, Edo state. In 2005, Pastor Roland met and married his wife of 20 years, Apostle Bridgett Baker, Pastor of "Jesus, It's Me Ministries."

At the age of 16, Pastor Roland gave his life to the Lord Jesus Christ as his Savior. In 1996, Roland prophetically moved from his country to Germany. This is where he became a staunch member of New Life Church which is a multi-racial, multinational and non-denominational church located in Düsseldorf, Germany. In 1999, Roland became an ordained

Deacon at New Life Church. Later, he became the personal assistant to the general overseer of the Church, Bishop Richard Aidoo. Roland mentored many brothers and sisters in Germany, many of whom have become ministers and preachers of the gospel today. He is blessed with the Grace of Church planting and growth. Before he left Germany for the United States in October 2007, the New Life Church had grown to 5 different branches.

Pastor Roland is a faithful and fearless teacher and preacher of the gospel. In the year 2000, he joined Pastor Lloyd Nwokeji to found the International Christian Fellowship in Bielefeld, Germany. Roland is also one of the founders of the Global Evangelistic Network, (GEN), now led by Evangelist Daniel Schott. Since arriving in the United States, he has preached in a number of different churches. As a man of God who has traveled extensively, he has the knowledge and experiences of Christian living across 3 continents: Africa, Europe and the Americas. Pastor Roland also speaks 4 different languages!

Pastor Roland received the call and confirmation to become a pastor. He and his wife joined the Vietnamese United Prayer Spiritual Warfare Global Conference in October 2023, as sanctioned by Bishop Richard Aidoo. They are very faithful members to the conference and travel extensively to do spiritual warfare and Kingdom Missions.

At present, Pastor Roland is a member of Faith City Church International in Altavista, VA, where Bishop Dwight Butler is the general overseer, along with his wife, Pastor Connie Butler. Pastor Roland is already making great strides and positive impact at Faith City International. Along with many other priorities in his calling, he has the burden to always pray, fellowship and partner with other Kingdom citizens in order to further advance and expand the kingdom of our Lord in America and around the world.

In June 2024, Pastor Roland had the pleasure of attending the 14th year anniversary of the Anointed Women Ministerial Training Team when it was held at Faith City Church. This is where he met Dr. Vivian Geter and has been a faithful partner on the "Day by Day" prayer line ever since.
