1.00 GENERAL The Regulations in 1.00 GENERAL in conjunction with USTA National and USTA Southern regulations shall apply to all League Divisions (Adult and Mixed); as well as Southern Combo and Tri-Level.

1.02 Governance

1.02A Waiver of Rules and Procedures Prohibited Printed below are the (NELACTA) Regulations as authorized by the USTA League Tennis Regulations, USTA Southern Section Regulations, and USTA Louisiana Regulations.

1.02B Amendments NELA CTA Coordinator may amend these (NELA CTA) Regulations with approval from the (NELA CTA governing body).

1.02C Written Interpretation The Local League Coordinator and/or Local League Council shall have the authority to interpret the (NELA CTA) Regulations.

1.04B Administration.

1.04B(3)c Local League Coordinators. Local league administrators who include Local League Coordinators and Board of Directors of the local Community Tennis Associations are responsible for administering and promoting the USTA League Programs in their area.

1.04B(3)c(i) League Code of Ethics. All league administrators will adhere to the USTA Southern Section League Tennis Officials Code of Ethics (http://www.southern.usta.com/USA-League-Tennis-Pages/9305_USTA_Southern_Section_League_Tennis_Officials_Code_of_Ethics_As_of_21804/)

1.04B(3)c(ii) League Coordinator Responsibilities. Establish procedures and regulations for all aspects of their local league that are not covered by the national, sectional or state regulations. A copy of the local regulations must be submitted to the State League Coordinator for review prior to the leagues team captain's meeting.

USTA League Tennis Regulations (National, Southern Section, State, Local) are available on (<u>http://www.nelouisianatennis.usta.com/</u> or Louisianatennis.com prior to the start of local league competition).

1.04B(3)c(iii) Captains Meeting. A mandatory team captain's meeting must be held prior to the start of league play for each local league program. Topics to be covered include local regulations (provide internet links to National, Sectional, State regulations), championships eligibility requirements, and deadlines. Local league coordinators should review all regulations and procedures with new team captains. The captains meeting may be held by any of the following methods: in person, conference call, video call, webinar or email communications.

1.04C Official Information System

1.04C(1)a Team Registration. The deadline date must be prior to the start of the local league season and must be no later than one (1) month of the state championship with local league schedules published with times and facilities of local league matches. See chart 1.04C for leaguespecific dates.

Team name format shall be as follows: Captain's LAST NAME/AGE GROUP/LEVEL /LEAGUE/FACILITY (MAX 4 LETTERS). Example: Smith/55/3.5/For

1.04C(1)b Player Additions. All player additions to existing registered team rosters must be made no later than 14 days prior to the state championship, including local leagues played during a state championship. See chart 1.04C for league specific dates.

1.04C(1)c League Fees & Financial Statement.

1.04C(1)d. The local Community Tennis Associations are responsible for making available a financial statement to the local team captains at the conclusion of each league year. A copy of financial statement can be obtain upon request from the NELACTA treasurer.

Any fees paid to the local league coordinator, level coordinators, league assistants, and/or league secretary must be itemized on the financial report.

1.04C(1)e Enrollment Fees. The 2023 (NELACTA) league year enrollment fees. (List by Program)

Any increase to Local League head tax must be approved by the USTA Louisiana Adult League Committee prior to the start of the leagues team registration.

1.04C(1)f Local League Refunds.

- Local League player refunds will only be issued for the following: injury, illness, or permanent move from local league area. Refunds only issued if a transfer is impossible in respective league year.
- Player must not have played any matches on team which requesting refund.
- Refund request must be made prior to the state championship for league in which refund is being requested.
- Refund request must be documented via email to the LLC and that request may be required for refund.
- Local league coordinators may move player registration to another league/team if player has not played any matches on team which requesting refund. Transfer of player registration can only be between 18/40 age group registrations to 18/40 age group team, 55 age group to 55 age group team.
- If player participated in a later league where registration could have been transferred, a refund will not be issued.
- Refunds will be administered once a year in December for all qualifying refunds request **that could not be transferred.**

1.04C(2) Official Score Reporting and Standings System The initial entry of match scores into TennisLink should take place within 48 hours of the completion of the match. After match scores have been entered in TennisLink, they must be confirmed by the opposing team within 48 hours of the initial entry or the initial score will automatically be considered valid. Failure to comply may subject teams to a grievance and/or double default.

1.04D Local League.

1.04D(3) Local League Season. All local league matches should be completed two (2) weeks prior to the state championship.

- All local leagues shall obtain the approval of the State League Coordinator for the dates of the local league season.
- Any Local League whose matches are published in TennisLink beyond the Local League deadline date set by USTA Louisiana will be ineligible to advance to the league's USTA Louisiana State Championship.

1.04D(4) Team. There is no limit to the number of players that appear on a team roster and no limit to the number of players on that roster that are at a specific NTRP level, with the exception of a two team league. Each team must have the minimum number of players shown in the table in the State Regulations. See 1.04D(5)

1.04D(5) Two Team Leagues. If any Adult Division Age Group consists of only two teams in a level of play, each team must maintain its roster with at least 40 percecnt of its players at the designated NTRP level of play. The exception is the Adult Division 55& Over Age Group that uses combined NTRP rating levels and will not be required to comply with this Regulation.

1.04D(6): Courts for Local League Play. The use of tennis-related blended lines is permitted on courts used for local league matches. Theuse of other lines for another sport, such as Pickleball, is not permitted on courts used for local league matches. Except as otherwise provided in local league regulations: 1. "Home teams" will have the choice of court surface for which they wish to playtheir home matches; and 2. Court surface must be the same surface for all Individual lines. (Southern Regulations.)

1.04E Player Eligibility

1.04E(1) Domicile and Residency Requirements USTA Louisiana will have no residency requirements for local league play. Exception: Any team playing a local league at a state championship and/or advance directly to a state championship(if applicable for the Adult 64 & Over league and/or play in a single weekend local league tournament) may have players from other areas as long as the majority of players reside in the State of Louisiana. Local League matches shall be scheduled the follow locations: Forsythe, Monroe Athletic Club, University of Monroe and Bayou Desiard.

1.04F Official League Rating Program

1.04F(1) Entry Players who do not have a valid NTRP rating level on file in TennisLink shall self- rate in accordance with the General & Experienced Player Guidelines – Supplement to the NTRP Guidelines and complete the self-rating process on TennisLink when registering for a team. Players who allow someone else to complete the self-rating process for them will be ultimately responsible and held accountable for information submitted or omitted. Failure to self-rate in accordance with the Guidelines, or omission of information regarding a player's tennis history, will subject the player as well as the captain and/or others who completed, assisted, condoned and/or approved an inappropriate self-rating to penalties under the League Suspension Point System. Players whose self-ratings are determined to be inaccurate or inappropriate shall be disqualified. (See Reg. 3.03E(1)a).

Self-ratings are valid for two years from the date issued or until replaced by a dynamic or computer rating. If there is a change in their playing experience the player may appeal their rating up at that time or they may be promoted by the Sectional coordinator.

1.04G PLAYER PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY.

1.04G(6). Any player who qualifies to advance to the USTA Louisiana State Championship in the Adult, Mixed, Southern Combo or Tri Level division may advance on more than one team within an age group only if they are different NTRP Levels.

No accommodations for scheduling will be made at the USTA Louisiana Championships for teams with players that may be competing on two or more teams during a state championship.

2.00 USTA LEAGUE REGULATIONS

2.01A NTRP Levels of Play. – refer to chart 2.01C(3)

2.01A(1)-When using straight NTRP levels, a player cannot have an NTRP rating higher than the NTRP level in which theplayer is competing.

2.01C(2)– **Team Match:** Each league will have the option to play either an eight game pro set or two sets with a third set tie breaker.

<u>2.01C(3)a.</u> When the combination of individual matchdefaults given by the two teams in the team match results, or would result, in a situation where the majority of the individual matches would not be played, captains shall notify the Local League Coordinator who will reschedule the remaining un-played individual matches.

2.01C(4) Match Scoring and Formats - see chart 2.01C(2)

- Match scoring shall be the following two formats:
 - 1. the best of three tiebreaker sets with a set tiebreaker (7pt) at 6-all. In the event of split sets, a match tiebreak (10pt) shall be played in lieu of a third set.
 - 2. 2.8-game pro sets.
- The team winning the majority of the individual matches shall be awarded one team point.
- 4 court match if tied 2-2, the tie shall be broken by the first of the following methods to do so: a)least sets lost, then b) least games lost; then c) game winning percentage; then d) winner of 1st court doubles.
- If a Local League has a playoff, championship procedures must be used in the event of a tie. Please refer to national regulation 2.03H.
- USTA Southern permits each local league to continue using the same local league team format through local league playoffs. Said team format for local league playoff structure shall be listed in each applicable local league regulations. All other requirements for "championship" play must be followed for local league playoffs.

2.01C(6) Team Lineups.

2.01C(5)c. Local League matches can only be cancelled by the local league coordinator. If match in progress is interrupted by rain, teams must wait one hour before rescheduling. If a rain delayed match can't be started within 60 minutes of scheduled match time, match should be rescheduled. If the temperature at match time fails below 40 degrees (day match) or 45 degrees (night match after 5:00 pm) match may be reschedule. Local League Coordinator MUST be notified prior to any rescheduled match. The Local League Coordinator will reschedule matches that have to

2.01C(5)e Team Defaults USTA Louisiana adopts the following regarding teams defaulting an entire team match during local league competition:

- The defaulting team may be ineligible to advance beyond local league as determined by the Adult League Council based upon the facts and circumstances presented by the local league coordinator.
- <u>Team remains obligated to play the remainder of all local league matches.</u> These matches will be recorded in <u>TennisLink for the purposes of satisfying match play requirements for opponents and NTRP calculations.</u>
- <u>All matches of a defaulting team may be removed from the stats and standings in TennisLink (if multiple round</u> robins, the defaulting team may be removed from that round of play) UNLESS:
 - <u>All teams with a mathematical chance to advance have already played the defaulting team in good faith, the</u> <u>matches shall stand as played when determining standings.</u>
 - Extenuating circumstances presented by the Local League Coordinator may be considered by the USTA Louisiana Adult League Council prior to the team being removed from standings.
- In addition, the local league coordinator may recommend the filing of a grievance with the local grievance committee.

2.01 Progression

2.02A(1) Local Competition All local matches should be completed two (2) weeks prior to the USTA Louisiana State Championship.

2.02A(2) Local Champion Advancing teams are required to register and pay entry fee for at least the leagues minimum number of players online through the championship website 10 days prior to the start of the state championship to guarantee spot in the state championship draw.

- Determine winner: The team with the most team points as recorded in TennisLink will be declared the winner.
- Please refer the 2023 USTA Louisiana Championship Procedures for full championship details including registration information, dates, location and procedures.

2.05C Appeal of Year-End Ratings.

Year-end NTRP valid computer rating levels may be appealed or denied through TennisLink except for 2.05D *Medical Appeals.*
