The In-Home Skilled Nursing Program is designed to serve eligible members based on a medical necessity determination for children under the age of 20 years 11 months.

Families who do not have Medicaid but has private insurance can qualify for the Katie Beckett Waiver which removes family income from the equation. Families are approved based on the child's need and not the families income.

The Georgia Pediatric Program is a Medicaid program that provides services to medically fragile children who are in need of skilled and unskilled services.

Intake and evaluation for GAPP typically takes up to 30 days for service approval.
