## Leadership Levels of Pilot International

Pilot International's highest level of volunteer leaders make up the PI Executive Board. There is a President, President-Elect, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and four Directors. Not only do they oversee the volunteer side of PI, but they are responsible for the six staff members that work at PIHQ (PI Headquarters); Will Butler (Chief Operating Officer/Director of Events), Lia Smith (Bookkeeper), Joanna Kotlarski (Membership Specialist), Neil Barker (PI Founders Fund Specialist), Mallory Morgan (Anchor and Youth Development Specialist), and Molly Wilkins (Communications Specialist).

The next level of leaders is the district level. There are 19 districts in Pilot International. Each district is governed by a District Administrative Council (DAC) or a District Executive Council (DEC). We are in the Northeast Potomac District, which presently has clubs only in Pennsylvania and New York, and we are governed by a DAC which is a Governor, Governor Elect, Secretary and Treasurer. Larger Districts have Lt. Governors. Each year a member of the PI Executive Committee is assigned to a district as their Executive Committee 'Representative (ECR).

Finally, there is club level leadership. The club is led by a President, President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, and a unspecific number of directors as an Executive Board. We have the immediate past President preside as the head of the directors and then we have four directors that serve two years and two rotate off each year so that there are always two seasoned directors on the Board.

## Leadership Grants

Did you know that there is money that you can apply for to help pay for registration fees and other costs for District Workshop and Convention, as well as International Convention? Well, there is. It's called a Leadership Grant. All you need to do is get an application from Dora, complete it, and return it to Dora. There is a small committee that reviews your application for approval. Funds come from donations and the yearly sub sale.
