The Nominating Process

January's Mentor topic is the nominating process and there are three levels of nominations; club level, district level, and International level. Starting with club level, the President-Elect automatically becomes the President at close of International Convention. This leaves the positions of President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, and two Directors (in our Club) open for nominations. The nominee should have the skill set to perform the duties of the office that are nominated for. At the district level, the Governor-Elect automatically becomes the Governor at the close of International Convention. The positions of Governor-Elect, Secretary, and Treasurer are open for nominations. A nominee for Governor Elect must have served as a Club President. Since we are considered a small district, our Secretary and Treasurer must have served on a club Executive Board. Finally, the International level; the President Elect automatically becomes the President at the close of International Convention. The positions of President Elect, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and four Directors are open to nominations. All International officer nominees must have served as a District Governor. If a nominee for Vice President to President Elect, the nominee must have served on the International Executive Committee for at least two years. Members of the club are encouraged to make nominations for all levels of Pilot. A letter is then sent to the nominee from the club asking for their acceptance of the nomination. Happy Nominating!
