The Drew Douglass Memorial Scholarship was created in loving memory of Drew “Boogie” Douglass of Chehalis. Drew was an amazing kid. He was hardworking, adventurous, kind-hearted, athletic and outgoing. He was caring to others and a friend to many. Despite always having a smile on his face; he, like many of his peers, silently struggled with anxiety and depression and ultimately took his own life at age of 14.

The nonprofit organization, Drew North Foundation, began in November of 2021 to raise awareness of mental health issues and provide resources for students that are in need. Our hope is that the scholarship inspires greater awareness about mental health and fuels innovative solutions that help the millions of people who are suffering. The Drew North Foundation is pleased to offer three scholarships in his honor.

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
2. Applicants must submit an essay describing why they feel passionate about this scholarship/foundation.

4. Please include your desire to attend college, technical/vocational school.
5. Applicants must include 1-2 letters of recommendation. Letters can be from a teacher, employer, or mentor.
