

MIKEAL ANTHONY GRETO & THE FLOOD

SINGER/ SONGWRITER/RECORDING ARTIST

Mikeal Anthony Greto is a multi-instrumentalist who started writing songs by the age of fourteen. After spending most of his musical career writing and performing in bands that collectively produced more than 8 albums worth of material, Mikeal's solo work is further pushing the boundaries of his craft. After losing his son in 2017, Mikeal is embracing songwriting at the most vulnerable time of his life.

Locked down in his home studio in 2020, Mikeal tracked guitars, bass, piano & mandolin and his debut solo EP, "Blue Roots (Vol. I)" was released on 9.22.22, what would have been his son's 21st birthday. Mixed at Forge Recording by Philly Scene staple and longtime friend Steven LaFashia, the EP was mastered by Sterling Sound's Calbi/Fallone and featured Chris Miller, Michael Crist, Cellist Maura Dwyer and a guest spot by Bad Company drummer Simon Kirke. With a new batch of songs in the works, "In Florescence (Vol. II)" is slated for release in 2024.
