• DRC Request From

Many projects will require a DRC form **BEFORE** you start them. Here is a small sample: expanding driveway, putting in a porch / new deck, replacing your fence, repainting your house (even if same color), dumpster in your driveway, mailbox, shed, etc.

What is Service Plus or the City of Thornton looking for during this time of year?

Weeds: Weeds cannot exceed eight inches in height anywhere on a lot.

Landscaping: Diseased or dead plant materials and trees shall be removed and replaced in a reasonable timeframe (30 days unless during winter).

Driveway: Your drive way should be free of stains, debris, trailer, inoperable cars.

Trash and Debris: Any accumulation of garbage, trash, appliances, old furniture, or scrap material must be removed from the property. Trash containers should be stored in areas away from the front yard or driveway, like inside a garage or shed, behind a fence or alongside the back of a house. Note: City trash container storage concerns are addressed by <u>Environmental Services</u> staff.

Mailbox: Must in good repair.

Fences: Fences along City streets must be maintained so that they do not lean or have more than one missing picket. Most back and side yard fences may not be more than six feet tall. A fence exceeding 30 inches requires a permit.

RVs, Trailers and Motor Homes: RVs, trailers and motor homes may only be parked on the street when actively loading or unloading the vehicle. However, four three-day

permits are available at no charge per calendar year. Permits are available at the Building Inspection Counter located in the City Development Building, 9500 Civic Center Drive (facing Sam's Club). A copy of the registration for the recreational vehicle, motor home or trailer is required at the time of application.

Click & Haul - bulky or large item collections

Event Dates: Click & Haul collections are scheduled during the work week, depending on your address. Thornton residents can use this service to: Get rid of clutter in the garage or basement, plan a do-it-yourself room remodel, clean up the yard or storage shed, get rid of recently replaced furniture or appliances, or for a rental property cleanup!

Location: Items must be placed in an orderly fashion (stacked/bundled) at the curb by 7 a.m. the day of the scheduled collection.

Guidelines: The cost is just \$65 per collection for 6 cubic yards of stuff that would fill two normal sized pickup truck loads. More than two full pickup loads = \$109 or more. Restrictions and limitations apply. The cost of service is placed on the next utility bill for payment. Furniture, appliances, mattresses/box springs, hot water heaters, fence panels, branches, remodeling debris, and evaporative coolers are eligible for pickup.

Restrictions: NO hazardous materials (i.e., flammable liquids, oil, paint, fertilizer, chemical cleaners, etc.). NO tires. NO concrete or masonry demolition (driveway concrete, wall blocks or gravel). NO televisions, computer monitors, DVD players, and other certain electronics.

Landfill Days

Event dates: September 19 **Event time:** 7 a.m. - 2 p.m.

Location: Republic Services Tower Landfill located at 88th Avenue and Tower Road in Commerce City

Guidelines: On specified dates, Thornton residents may take non-hazardous debris to a designated landfill and the gate fee is waived. One vehicle load per household. All loads must be covered. Commercial loads are subject to applicable fees. Pickup trucks, cars, and small single-axle trailer loads only. Proof of residency is required and limitations apply. Freon charged units (refrigerators, A/C units, and freezers) and electronics such as televisions and computer monitors will not be accepted. No tires, car batteries, medical waste, ammunition, fireworks, fluorescent bulbs, or liquids of any kind. *Mattresses are subject to an additional fee of \$30 each.*

Tree Branch & Compost Drop-off

Event dates: July 11, August 8, September 12 **Event times:** 8 a.m. - Noon

Location: Thornton's Infrastructure Maintenance Center (IMC) 12450 Washington Street. Use the north entrance with access on 126th Avenue east of Washington Street.

Guidelines: On specified dates, Thornton residents may bring tree branches, limbs, and compostable material to the IMC. Proof of residency is required. You will be responsible for unloading your branches and all compost material. Compost material must be placed in BPI certified fully compostable bags, paper sacks, or be prepared to open any other bag and empty on site.

Free Mulch

Thornton residents can pick up free mulch for their yards **Monday-Friday between 6:30am and 5pm** at **8651 Colorado Blvd**. The mulch bin is located inside the gate immediately to the right. One truckload per resident, hand shoveling only. Contact the Parks Division to find out if there is mulch available: parks@thorntonco.gov or 303-255-7833.

Animals running at Large (Sec. 6-7): Your domestic animal (cats, dogs, etc.) must be confined to your property and not be allowed to wander off. When off your property, animals must be on a leash where you have effective and immediate control over them. Common areas are not considered owner's premises, and animals must be under control in common areas.
