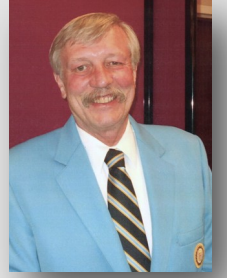

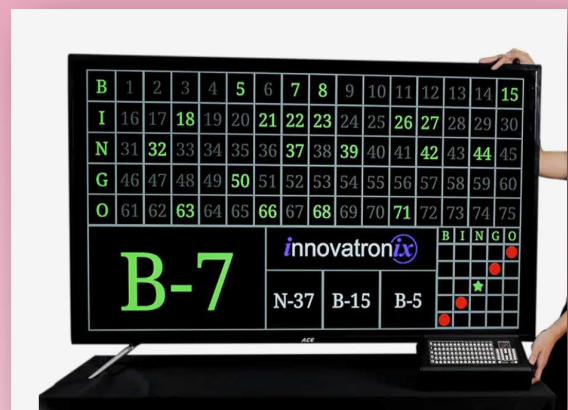
Volunteers will be needed for the next BIG annual event, the LUAU, on July 11. Signup sheets and tickets for this event will be up later this month.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR TREASURER

Many of you have come up to me this past year asking me why we had to raise our dinner and drink prices by a dollar, so I thought I provide you with our annual results for the 2025/2026 year.

All in all, we had a good year, thanks to all who donated to the different causes (Women's Restroom Upgrade, Playground, Fire Insurance...) Our Total Bar and food sales for the year was \$233,340, on top of that we had an additional \$94,399 in misc. income/donations (Thank you again) for total income of \$336,431. Our Total operating cost for the lodge this year came in at \$329,299 giving the lodge a positive cash flow of \$7,132.

You ask how did the \$1.00 increase in dinners and drinks affect this number? Over the year we took in approximately an additional \$28,000. That \$1 adds up with our members buying food and drinks over the year. If we did not increase the prices the lodge would have had a shortfall of **\$20,868**.

I know price increases are never popular and I am hopeful that this coming year our prices will remain the same. I thank all of you for your continued support of our lodge.

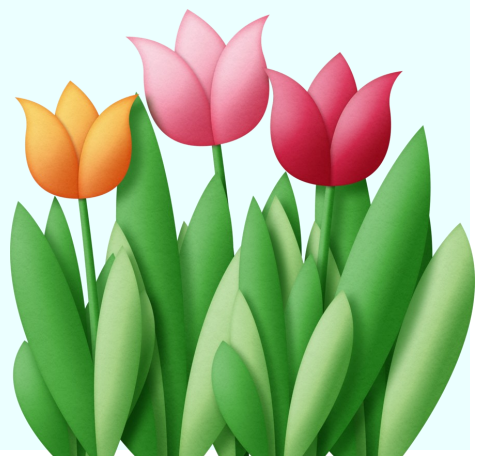

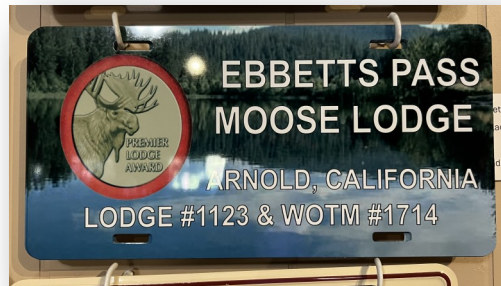
