Administrator's Update



Welcome Fall!

Thank you to all that volunteered at our many summer events. We could not have such a successful summer without you. We have two more events in September; the Logging Jamboree and our annual Rib Feed. Tickets for the Rib Feed are now available at the bar.

I want to talk about how to record your volunteer time online at mooseintl.org. under "My Membership Record." When you start to add your time under "Volunteer Type" there are 2 different categories; Moose-initiated Heart of the Community and Lodge Volunteer Activity.

Moose-initiated Heart of Community (HOC) is the official core program that our Lodge participates in. There are core initiatives (Mooseheart, Moosehaven, Tommy Moose, Safe Surfin' USA, Valued Veterans' program) and companion initiatives like local charity drives, Holiday Food programs that our lodge participates in. Participation is tracked through Quarterly HOC Reports that I turn in from our Lodge. These reports count monetary donations, volunteer hours and miles driven, with a point system to determine grades (Superior, Excellent, Good) and help us reach Premier status for the year.

You should enter your hours under "Lodge Volunteer Activity." This refers to individual or group volunteer hours. Volunteers can work on local projects, charitable events or community service that benefit the community but are not necessarily tied to the Moose HOC. Your volunteer hours inside the lodge should also be recorded (workdays, meals, major events, etc.) and count towards loyalty rewards that you can earn toward things like catalog gift certificates and cruises.

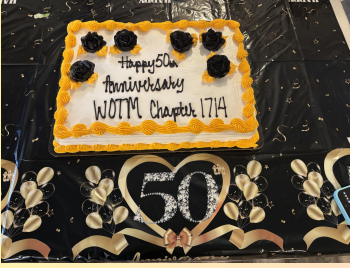

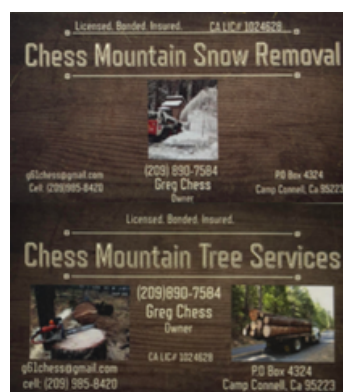
