The 2025-2026 Board of Officer Elections is one month away. Any member in good standing desiring to run for an elective office must submit his or her name with an "Intent to Run" form to the Nominating Committee by Tuesday, March 11. Forms are available from the Administrator with a list of responsibilities for each Office. Place the "Intent to run" form in the Administrator's office door.

Office Eligibility:

President – Has been an active member of the lodge for at least 6 months immediately prior to the date of election and has completed at least 1 year in another elected office (not a combination of offices) of the lodge in which he or she seeks office.

Vice President – Has been an active member of the lodge for at least 6 months immediately prior to election

Chaplain – Has been an active member of the lodge for at least six 6 months immediately prior to the election

Treasurer - Must be an active member of the lodge

Trustee - Must be an active member of the lodge

Timeline:

Tuesday, February 11 - Report of Nominating Committee time and place of meetings

Tuesday, March 11 - Deadline to submit to an "Intent to Run" form to the Administrator

Tuesday, March 11 - Nominating Committee reports those nominated for office at the general membership meeting

If a member submits an Intent to run form and is not nominated by the Nominating Committee, they can get a petition form from the Administrator and submit the completed petition back to the Administrator by Tuesday, March 25, to have their name placed on the ballot.

General Election:

Voting will be held Tuesday, April 5, between 3 - 7 p.m. in the Social Quarters. If there are multiple candidates for any office, the vote will be by ballot. If there is only one candidate for all offices, the vote will be by show of hands at the membership meeting provided the procedure is approved by the membership at the March 15 membership meeting. The Election Committee will make their report to members at the April 5 general membership meeting.


